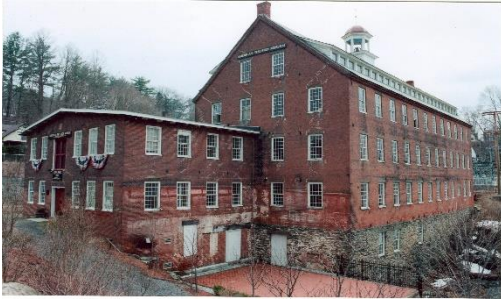




Summer 2024 Travel Program: The Best of Burlington: August 27-29, 2024



Explore beautiful Burlington, Vermont in support of the New England Air Museum

Day 1: American Precision Museum & Lake Champlain Dinner Cruise

Our trip begins with an 8:00am departure from the New England Air Museum via a luxury motorcoach with an onboard restroom. We'll arrive at the American Precision Museum at approximately 11:00am and enjoy a behind-the-scenes tour, self-guided time, and a boxed lunch. After checking-in to our accommodations at the Courtyard Burlington Harbor along Lake Champlain, we'll enjoy a buffet dinner cruise of the lake with aboard the *Spirit of Ethan Allen*.

Day 2: Shelburne Museum & Shelburne Vineyard

After a hot buffet breakfast at our hotel, we'll travel to the Shelburne Museum for a self-guided visit of their stunning 45-acre campus filled with historic buildings, material culture, and art. A lunch voucher is included in your admission ticket. We'll finish the day with a winery tour and wine tasting at nearby Shelburne Vineyard before returning to our hotel for the evening. Dinner will be on your own in downtown Burlington, with dozens of local restaurants and craft breweries within walking distance.

Day 3: Vermont Air National Guard Base & Quechee Inn

After a hot buffet breakfast at our hotel, we'll check-out and travel to the Vermont Air National Guard Base for a guided tour. Government issued photo ID will be required to access the military base. We'll finish our visit to Vermont with a stop at the historic Quechee Inn for a buffet lunch before returning to the New England Air Museum at approximately 6:00pm.

**Travel Program Fee: \$1,500 per person Single Occupancy
\$1,125 per person Double Occupancy, Non-members add \$100 per person**

Fee includes complimentary parking at the New England Air Museum; museum admission and tour fees; departure coffee and breakfast pastries; bottled water and snacks; one dinner, two hot breakfasts, and two lunches; first class hotel accommodations with free wi-fi; roundtrip luxury motor coach transportation with an onboard restroom; taxes, gratuities, and guide services. This trip is limited to 39 participants and a \$500 per person deposit is required to secure spots.
