The safety and integrity of the nation's food chain from biological attack was scrutinized after the attacks of September 11th, 2001 and the United States governing agencies (FDA, USDA, et. al.) are asking the entire industry from farm to fork to establish and maintain any means they can to detect, prevent, and respond to such an attack. Public law 107-188, June 12, 2002 (commonly known as the "Bioterrorism Act of 2002") requires Suppliers of food materials and products to and within the United States to be registered with the FDA or USDA and to comply with all requirements of the Bioterrorism Act of 2002. Once Again Nut Butter developed and continually maintains procedures currently in place to support protection of the food supply chain. Good relationships are developed and maintained with our suppliers/vendors and distributors to reduce the risk of incident. OANB will continue to maintain, evaluate, and improve procedures and policies that address product protection, inventory control and secure storage, secure transportation, visitors and contractors, site security and access, trace/recall capability, document retention, employee training, employee screening, and the overall Food Defense Program. A Food Defense Team is established to review, monitor, and update the overall program. Programs and Procedures are audited and reviewed on an annual basis. Once Again Nut Butter is in compliance with the FDA Bioterrorism Act of 2002 will maintain Registration renewals at required intervals.
