General Jack Sheehan joined the United States Marine Corps in 1962, serving in Vietnam and Gulf War I. Before retiring from military service in 1997, he undertook the roles of Supreme Allied Commander Atlantic for NATO and Commander-in-Chief for the U.S. Atlantic Command. He advised US Presidents George Bush Snr and Bill Clinton. In 1998, Jack joined Bechtel International as a Senior Vice President.

Jack Sheehan will be speaking about collaboration, coaching the business leaders of the future, and passing on the lessons he has learned from the military and business. He will describe his experiences working as Operations Director in the White House and discuss the characters he encountered in his career.
