## 2809-Ribbed Beanie Free Pattern

| Materials: | 100 grams of 14 Ply Yarn <br> or 2 balls of contrasting coloured yarns <br> 6 mm Needles |
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| Needles: | Darning Needle |
| Pattern: | K2 P2 Rib for main body aligned |
| Tensions: | $2 \times 2$ rib $=10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ rib on 6 mm needles <br> Length: |
| $27 \mathrm{cms}-44 \mathrm{cms}$ width |  |

Cast on 66 sts and work $2 \times 2$ rib, beginning with K3 sts, $2 \times 2$ rib, then ending the row with $3 P$
Work until the ribbing measures 22 mm or longer, depending on the amount of turn up required ending with a WS row. Use complementing colours as required through the hat body and shaping to add interest, keeping the pattern stitch accurate at all times.


## SHAPING FOR CROWN

Row 1: K3, *p2tog, K2, P2, K2*, repeat from * to * until last 7 sts, P2tog, K2, P3 (58 sts)
Row 2: Knit all knit sts and purl all purls sts
Row 3: K3 * P1, K2, P2tog, K2*, repeat from * to * until last 6 sts P1, K2, P2tog, p1 (50sts)
Row 4: Knit all knit sts and purl all purl sts.
Row 5: K1, *k2tog, P1, K2, P1 * repeat from * to * until last stitch P1 (42 sts)

Row 6: Knit all knit sts and purl all purl sts
Row 7: K2, *P1, K2tog, P1, K1*, repeat from * to * untils last 5 sts, P1, K2tog, P2 (34sts)
Row 8: Knit all knit sts and purl all purl sts.
Row 9: *K2tog, repeat from * to last 2 sts P2tog (17sts)
Row 10: purl all sts to last stitch, K1

Row 11: K2tog, repeat from * to end P1, (9 sts)
Cut the yarn but leaving enough yarn to pull through the stitches on the needle and do the back seam,
