You can make approx 5 of these dishcloths with one ball of Rosarios 4 Lar, Doce Lar!

Basic Corner to Corner Diagonal Dishcloth (With extra pointy corners!!)

Materials: Any worsted weight kitchen cotton.

Needles: Size 4.50mm or 5.00mm

Gauge: Gauge is not important for this project.

Directions: Cast on 3 sts Increase half

Every other row is knit plain except where noted.

K2, m1 (I do a backwards loop), k1 (4 sts)

K2, yo, K2 (5 sts)

K2, yo, k1, y0, k2 (7 sts)

K2, yo k3, yo, k2 (9 sts)

Continue increasing until you have 43 sts

Pointy Corners

Turn your work to make your plain knit row

K2, turn back, k2, turn right, k2, knit to end, turn, k2, turn, k2.

These are short rows. If you are unsure of how to make them please see knittinghelp.com for an instructional video

Decrease half

K1, k2tog, yo, k2tog, knit to last 5, k2tog, yo, k2tog, k1.

Continue decreasing until you have 9 sts

Endgame (centered final eyelets)

K1, k2tog, yo, s1 k2tog psso, yo, k2tog, k1 (7 sts)

K1, k2tog, yo, s1 k2tog psso, k1 (5 sts)

K1, s1 k2tog psso, k1 (3 sts)

Bind off & weave in ends



Diamonds in the Rough

Rosarios 4 Lar, Doce Lar! 1 set single point needles, size 4.50mm

Cast On 38 sts.

Work 5 rows in garter st.

(seed st can be substituted for border, including the K4 at beginning & end of rows)

Begin pattern:

Row 1: K4, *P1, K4*(6x), K4

Row 2: K4, *P3, K2*(6X), K4

Row 3: K4, *P3, K2*(6X), K4

Row 4: K4, *P1, K4*(6X), K4

Row 5: K4, P Across, K4

Row 6: K4, *K4, P1*(6X), K4

Row 7: K4, *K2, P3*(6X), K4

Row 8: K4, *K2, P3*(6X), K4

Row 9: K4, *K4, P1*(6X), K4

Row 10: K4, P Across, K4

Work pattern 5x.

Note: Skip Row 10 on the last repeat.

Work 5 rows in garter st.

Bind off.



Dragonfly Washcloth

Yarn: 100% Cotton Medium/Worsted Yarn (84 metres - yields 1-2 washcloths)

Needles: Size 4.50mm Needles (or size needed for gauge) Gauge: 5 sts = 1" in stst

Instructions: Cast on 37 stitches.

Rows 1-7: Knit Row 8: and all wrong side rows through row 50: K4, P29, K4

Row 9: Knit Row 11: Knit

Row 13 and all right side rows through row 25: K18, P1, K18 Row 27: K8, P4, K6, P1, K6, P4, K8

Row 29: K9, P5, K4, P1, K4, P5, K9 Row 31: K12, P4, K1, P3, K1, P4, K12 Row 33: K7, P5, K4, P5, K4, P5, K7 Row 35: K5, P27, K5 Row 37: K6, P9, K3, P1, K3, P9, K6 Row 39: K17, P1, K1, P1, K17 Row 41: K13, P1, K2,

P1, K3, P1, K2, P1, K13 Row 43: K14, P2, K5, P2, K14 Row 45: Knit

Row 47: Knit Row 49: Knit

Rows 51- 56: Knit Bind off all stitches

Knit Dress Dish Cloth Going Dancing By Knit n Sew Studio

Materials: Worsted Weight Cotton Yarn -Less than one skein

Size 5.00mm Knitting Needles, Crochet Hook

Cast on 40 stitches

SKIRT

Row 1 (WS) K2,P36,K2 Row 2 (RS) Knit Row 3 K2,P36,K2

Row 4 K2,*(K2tog tbl) twice; (YO, K1) 4 times; (K2tog tbl) twice; rep from * twice more; K2

Row 5 Knit Row 6-25 Repeat Rows 2-5 five times

WAIST & BODICE

Row 26 – K1, (K2 tog tbl) 19 times; K1 (21 stitches)

Row 27 – K1, (P2 tog) 4 times; P3; (P2 tog) 4 times; K1 (13 stitches)

Row 28 - K1, (K2 tog tbl, K1) 4 times (9 stitches) Row 29 - K1, P7, K1 Row 30 - Knit

Row 31 - K1, P7, K1 Row 32 - K2, increase in next stitch, K3, increase in next stitch, K2 (11 stitches)

Row 33 - K1, P9, K1 Row 34 - K3, increase in next stitch, K3, increase in next stitch, K3 (13 stitches)

Row 35 - K1, P11, K1 Row 36 - Knit Row 37 - K1, P11, K1 Row 38 - K4, Bind off center 5, K3

SHOULDER & NECKLINE

On 4 stitches on one side

Row 39 - Purl Row 40 - Knit Row 41 - Purl

Bind off these 4 stitches. Reattach yarn to 4 stitches on other side at neckline (WS facing) and repeat rows 39-41 Bind off leaving last loop to begin crochet loop & neckline trim. Starting with loop from bind off – chain 10 & attach to other side of neckline. Single crochet around neck opening. Single crochet in each chain for hanger
