


MATERIALS AND MEASUREMENTS

To fit size	56	61	66	71	cm

Needle sizes

8ply: 3mm (US 3) and 3.5mm (US 4) needles; stitch holder, markers. Approx 1.5m of 22mm-wide double faced satin ribbon in matching pink for ties, sewing needle and thread.

The quantities of yarn stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

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ABBREVIATIONS

Beg - beginning; cm - centimetres; cont - continue; dec - decrease; inc - increase; ins - inches; k - knit; meas - measures; NR - next row; patt - pattern; rem - remaining; rep - repeat; RSF - right side facing; skp - slip 1 st, k 1 st, pass slipped st over; st(s) - stitch(es); Stst - Stocking/Stockinette stitch (K on RS rows/P on WS rows); tbl - through back of loop; tog - together; WS - wrong side.

IMPORTANT

Use ONLY the Naturally yarn specified. (We cannot accept

responsibility for an imperfect garment if any other brand is used.) Follow our instructions exactly.

We advise every knitter to check their tension carefully before commencing the garment.

All measurements in this design are based on the stated tension therefore it is essential that the correct tension be obtained and maintained throughout the garment to achieve success. We recommend the needle size we have used to obtain the tension BUT as each knitter knits differently it may be

necessary for some knitters to change their needle size accordingly.

CHECK YOUR TENSION CAREFULLY

If there are too many stitches to the inch then your tension is tight and you will need to change your needle to a larger size. If there are too few stitches to the inch then your tension is loose and you will need to change your needle to a smaller size.

TENSION

24 sts and 34 rows over Stst - 10cm (4ins) on 3.5mm (US 4) needles.

BACK

With 3mm (US 3) needles, cast on 65 (71, 77, 85) sts.

Work in k1, p1 rib for 8 rows. Change to 3.5mm (US 4) needles.

Work in Stst until piece meas 14 (17, 19, 20) cm from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Armholes

Cast off 2 (3, 3, 4) sts beg next 2 rows - 61 (65, 71, 77) sts.

NR (RS) - K1, skp, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

P 1 row straight.

Rep last 2 rows 3 times more. Cont to dec every other RS row twice more - 49 (53, 59, 65) sts. Cont straight until piece meas 27 (31.5, 35.5, 38) cm from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Neck

NR (RS) - K17 (18, 20, 22) sts, Turn, on these sts only.

Cast off 3 sts beg next 3 WS rows.

Cast off rem 8 (9, 11, 13) sts for shoulder.

Return to rem sts, slip next 15 (17, 19, 21) sts to holder for centre Back neck, rejoin yarn and work 2nd half to match first, reversing shaping.

LEFT FRONT

With 3mm (US 3) needles, cast on 65 (71, 77, 85) sts.

Work in k1, p1 rib for 8 rows. Change to 3.5mm (US 4) needles.

NR (RS) - K to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

NR (WS) - P1, p2tog, p to end. Rep last 2 rows 6 (6, 6, 7) times more (14 (14, 14, 16) dec rows have been worked) - 51 (57, 63, 69) sts.

NR (RS) - K to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

P 1 row straight.

Cont to dec as established every RS row only until piece

meas 14 (17, 19, 20) cm from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Armhole

NR (RS) - Cast off 2 (3, 3, 4) sts, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

P 1 row straight.

NR (RS) - K1, skp, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

P 1 row straight.

Rep last 2 rows 3 times more. Keeping Front edge shaping correct every RS row, dec 1 st for armhole every other RS row twice.

Work straight at armhole edge, cont to shape Front edge until 8 (9, 11, 13) sts rem for shoulder.

Work straight until Front meas same as Back to shoulder. Cast off.

RIGHT FRONT

With 3mm (US 3) needles, cast on 65 (71, 77, 85) sts.

Work in k1, p1 rib for 8 rows. Change to 3.5mm (US 4) needles.

NR (RS) - K1, skp, k to end. NR (WS) - P to last 3 sts, p2tog tbl, p1.

Rep last 2 rows 6 (6, 6, 7) times more (14 (14, 14, 16) dec rows have been worked) - 51 (57, 63, 69) sts.

NR (RS) - K1 skp, k to end. P 1 row straight.

Cont to dec as established every RS row only until piece meas 14 (17, 19, 20) cm from beg, end with a RS row.

Shape Armhole at beg of WS rows as for Right Front, AT SAME TIME, cont to dec for Front edge every RS row.

Work straight at armhole edge, cont to shape Front edge until 8 (9, 11, 13) sts rem for shoulder.

Finish Right Front to match Left.

Cast off at end.

SLEEVES

With 3mm (US 3) needles, cast on 39 (41, 43, 45) sts.

Work in k1, p1 rib for 8 rows. Change to 3.5mm (US 4) needles.

Work in Stst and inc 1 st each end next RS row then every 4th row to 69 (77, 85, 93) sts.

Cont straight until sleeve meas 23 (25.5, 29, 33) cm from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Top

Cast off 2 (3, 3, 4) sts beg next 2 rows.

NR (RS) - K1, skp, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

Work 1 row straight.

Rep last 2 rows 4 times more. Dec 1 st each end next 16 (18, 20, 22) rows.

Cast off 3 sts beg next 4 rows. Cast off rem 11 (13, 17, 19) sts.

COMPLETE

Block pieces to measurements. Use mattress st to sew all seams.

Join shoulder seams.

FRONT EDGING

With 3mm (US 3) needles, pick up and k 94 (102, 108, 116) sts up Right Front edge to shoulder seam, pick up and k 11 sts down Back neck, k across sts of Back neck holder, pick up and k 11 sts up Back neck and 94 (102, 108, 116) sts down Left Front edge - 225 (243, 257, 275) sts.

Work in k1, p1 rib for 4 rows. Cast off loosely in rib.

Insert sleeve tops, beg at shoulder seam.

Join side seams leaving a 2cm opening at right side seam just above ribbing.

Join sleeve seams.

Lightly press seams on wrong side.

TIES


Cut an approx 46 cm length of ribbon. Fold end under 0.5cm and sew 2cm to inside of right front bottom corner.

Cut a 77 (80, 82, 87) cm length of ribbon and sew in same way to left front bottom corner.

Pass left tie through opening in right side seam and tie in a bow.
