


Universal Net User Manual

This net is designed to fit trampolines of all shapes and sizes.



The Net is a long piece of material. Once installed around your frame the rest of the material should be cut thus leaving a bit extra fabric for stability.



Step 1:


Lay out the net on the trampoline.



STEP 2:


Start by connecting the Bottom of the Net to the bottom of the trampoline with Rope. To install the rope, make a knot at one end of the rope.

Start by inserting the other end of the rope to the beginning of the safety net entrance. Weave it through the net and V-rings through every second V-ring.




STEP 3:

Continue connecting the rope to every second v-ring (make sure to make it the tightest possible) until you reach at the point from where you begin,



STEP 4:

Now continue overlapping the net until the next pole or atleast \40 inches over the net from outside.



STEP 5:

Begin Installing the top Net on the poles or arches from the same place you begin at the bottom with the bungee cords (see next pages for details how to connect the cords), continue until you reach again at the point where you begin.




STEP 6: Now overlap to the outside until the next pole.




For Straight Poles

Note: If The net does not stretch to the top of the trampoline follow option 2 (last step on the manual).




1) Start by inserting the bungee cords through a hole of the net and pole cap as shown in figure





2) Put one end of the cord into the other ends loop and pull.




3) Pull down tightly








4) With the cords end form a knot around the pole caps loop




5) Continue to the next pole. Make sure to stretch the net as much as you can to avoid sagging.




6) Repeat step to all poles as shown in fig.

For Arches


Connect the Bungee cords to the arches as show below.



1) Start by inserting the bungee cord through a hole of the net and around the top of the arch pole as shown in figure.




2) Put one end of the cord into the other ends loop and pull.




3) Pull down tightly.


4) With the cords end form a knot around the Arch




5) Repeat step to all arches as shown in fig. (You will need two cords per arch)




Option 2: If the net does not stretch to the top of your trampoline you will need some space between the net and pole caps. Follow steps below:




1) Start by inserting the bungee cord through a hole of the net as shown in figure.




2) Put one end of the cord into the other ends loop and pull.




3) Pull the end of cord by holding the net to tighten the knot.




4) Insert the bungee cord in the c-shape loop of pole cap.




5) Open the cord as shown in figure and put the cap through the opening.



6) Pull the pole cap to make the knot at the c shape loop of pole cap.
