Some Notes

When attaching the mount to the rifle, you need to always:

- 1. Put it back in the same place
- 2. Push FORWARDS on the mount to press the recoil lug into the rail
- 3. Hold the mount firm while closing the lever
- 4. Proper Picatinny Rails are required
- 5. The rail must be clean, small amounts of debris can change the point of impact
- 6. Adjust the level tension evenly so it is firm with the allen bolts
- 7. TEST it before hunting

They are good mounts and allow you to either move the scope between rifles, or to dual use the scope as a handheld and a riflescope
