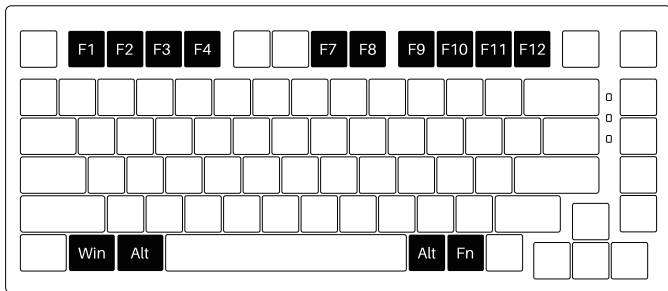

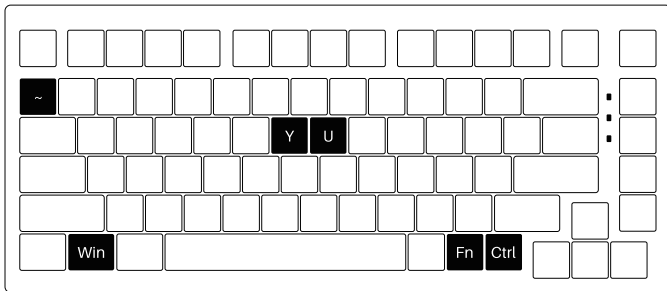

LED Indicator

- 1.CAPSLock
 - 2.Mac OSX Mode
- *Battery Level Indicator(MG75W)
Slow flashing white LED when in low battery
LED light on when in charging
LED light off after a full charging
- 3.Lock Win

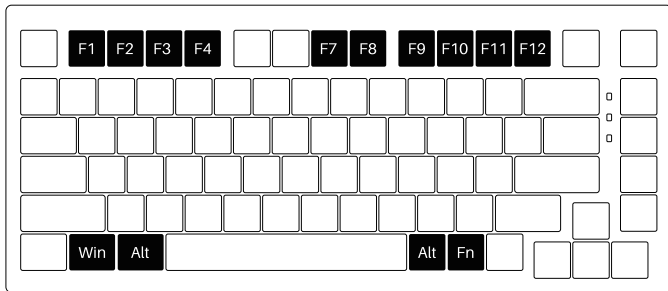

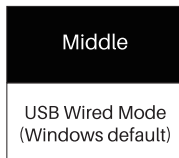

MG75 Operation Mode Switch

- *The built-in battery will start to power when the back switch is in the non-USB mode (either Mac or Win).
The keyboard will switch to USB wired mode automatically once USB cable is plugged in.
- *The switch will complete when the LED indicator flashes for 3 times.



- 1.The key/lighting effects customization can be programmed with MonsGeek Driver.

Note:

MG75 Battery Level Indicator

Low Battery: Slow flashing white LED

Charging: Constant white LED

Fully Charged: LED off
