QUICK PRINTER CONNECTION

1. Make sure the printer is off.



2. Connect the power adapter to the printer.



Plug the power cable into the outlet.



4. Connect the USB cable to the printer.



5. Connect the USB cable to the computer.



6. Turn the printer on.



7. Use the original power cord to install the above steps to connect.

LOADING THE LABELS

- Open the lid of the printer using the latches located on either side of the printer.
- Place the label roll with paper label facing up.
- · Slide the roll of labels onto the internal label spool.
- · Slide the end pieces onto each end of the spool.
- Insert the label holder into the two slots inside the printer.
- · Feed the labels into the two gray levers to the desired width.
- Pull labels forward until a portion of the label is extended past the front of the printer.
- Close the lid of the printer and turn it on.
 - The labels will automatically adjust for printing and the printer will detect connection with your computer.
 - Only use direct thermal printer labels. Thermal transfer labels are not supported with this model.



Your printer comes with a sample roll of labels that can feed into the back slot of the printer.

INSTALLING THE DRIVER

To install on a Windows OS PC:

- · Follow the steps on page 5 to connect the printer to your computer.
- Insert the flash drive that came with your printer into your computer's USB port.
- Double click on the Westinghouse driver icon and select Yes.
 NOTE: Administrator access may be required to download the driver.
 If required, enter the username and password for your administrator account.
- · Select Install Printer and click Next.

FOR WINDOWS



- Type Printers and Scanners in the search bar located near the bottom of your computer screen.
- Select the Printers and Scanners icon. A new window will open displaying a list of printers that are connected to your computer.



• Select WHTP203e under the list of printers (not under unspecified). Click Manage and select Printing Preferences.



FOR WINDOWS



• The default label size located under Stock is set for the standard shipping label size, 4"x6".

FOR WINDOWS

- For a different size, choose your size from the drop down menu located under Stock. You can also create a new size by selecting New and inputting your specific measurements. Click Apply.
- The printer speed and density (darkness) can be adjusted under Options. We recommend leaving these at their default values until you begin printing.
- · Click OK to close the window.
- Under the same Manage tab, select Print Test Image. This will print a generic test page and ensure that your printer is properly connected.

FOR MAC

To install on a Mac:

- · Follow the steps on page 5 to connect the printer to your computer.
- Insert the flash drive that came with your printer into your computer's USB port. NOTE: If your computer requires USB-C connections, you may need an adapter for your device to connect the printer to your computer.
- · An introduction window will open. Click Continue.



• From the Installation Type window, click Install. **NOTE:** You may be prompted to enter your computer password here.

• After entering your password, click the Install Software button and wait for the software to install.

• To adjust label size, select the drop down beside Default Paper Size to select your desired label size. Close the window.

To install on a Linux-based machine:

- Insert the flash drive that came with your printer into your computer's USB port.
- · Open the folder containing the driver and right click the driver.
- Select Open with Other Applications. A window will appear requesting you to Select Application.

FOR LINUX

- The default page size is 4x6. To choose a different size, select the desired size from the drop-down menu or select custom to change the size. Page orientation can also be changed in this window.
- To adjust the density/darkness of the print, select Image Quality and adjust the Darkness accordingly. **NOTE:** The higher the number, the more heat is applied to the label which produces a darker image. Adjust this until the image is at its best appearance.

OPERATION



Ensure labels are correctly placed in the printer.

- Turn the printer off for 3 seconds.
- Turn the printer back on while holding the feed button (located on top of the printer).
- When the printer beeps or the light on the feed button blinks, let go of the feed button.



MAINTENANCE



To ensure optimal print quality, we recommend cleaning the print head in the following situations:

- After every change in label roll.
- · When you notice a decrease in print quality.

Cleaning the print head:

- Turn off the printer.
- Open the printer lid using the latches located on either side.
- · Carefully wipe the print head with a lint free cloth.
- For sticky residue, apply a very small amount of 91% or higher content alcohol to a lint free cloth and gently clean the roller. Higher alcohol content accelerates drying time, preventing damage to electronic components.

Cleaning the Rubber Roller:

- · Turn off the printer.
- Open the printer lid using the latches located on either side.
- Gently wipe the platen rubber roller with a lint free cloth.
- For sticky residue, apply a very small amount of 91% or higher content alcohol to a lint free cloth and gently clean the roller. Higher alcohol content accelerates drying time, preventing damage to electronic components.

1. WHY ISN'T MY SHIPPING LABEL PRINTING CORRECTLY?

Paper size is not set correctly when switching to print labels of different sizes.



For Windows:

 Go to the Page Setup tab under Printing Preferences. Under Stock Name, select the correct size for your label.

• If your label is not printing correctly, go to Printers and Scanners and select the correct size from the drop-down menu. The default label size is 4 x 6".

2. WHY IS MY PRINTER PRINTING BLANK LABELS?

- Ensure you're using Direct Thermal Labels. Thermal Transfer Labels are not supported with this model.
- Check label loading orientation (sticker side facing up, back of the sheet facing down).

3. WHY IS MY LABEL PRINTING TOO SMALL OR TOO BIG?

• Adjust label size settings on the platform (eBay, Amazon, UPS, etc.) to match the label size (e.g., 4x6inch).

4. MY PRINTER IS RECEIVING AN ERROR MESSAGE AND IS NOT PRINTING.

For Windows:

- First, remove the print job from the Printer Queue, type 'Printer' in the search bar, then select 'Printers & Scanners'. Look for the WHTP203e icon, then select "Open Queue", select the "Printer" tab, then select "Cancel All Documents".
- Locate the WHTP203e icon, select "Open Queue", then "Printer" and finally "Cancel All Documents".
- · Change Printer Port.
- To change the Printer Port, type 'Printer' in the search bar, then select 'Printers & Scanners'. Look for the WHTP203e icon, then select "Manage", then select "Printer Properties", then select "Ports", then select the cor-

rect port. If there is more than one USB port, select the USB port with the highest end number. (e.g., If USB001 and USB002 are taken, select USB003).

• This is a common issue when the wrong port is selected. To fix this, you will need to clear all print jobs from the Printer Queue, then change the port to the correct one.

5. WHY IS MY PRINTER NOT BEING RECOGNIZED ON MY COMPUTER?

- Check printer power, USB connection, and LED status.
- Ensure power adapter and USB cables are properly connected.

6. WHY DOES THE DRIVER SHOW AS A SUSPICIOUS OR POTENTIAL VIRUS WHEN INSTALLING?

• Some antivirus software or firewall settings may flag the driver as a potential risk. The drivers have been tested as safe, proceed accordingly.

7. CAN I USE ANY LABELS IN THIS PRINTER?

 Most direct thermal labels are supported, but proprietary labels may have compatibility issues. For example, Dymo Brand labels may only be supported on Dymo printers.

8. WHY ARE THERE WHITE SPOTS OR DEAD PIXEL LINES ON THE LABELS WHEN I PRINT?

- Inspect and clean the printhead and rubber roller inside the printer. (See Maintenance section of manual)
- Ensure the rubber roller (Platen Roller) is clean and undamaged for optimal printing quality. (See Maintenance section of manual) on how to clean the roller properly.

9. WHY IS THE PRINTED LABEL NOT CLEAR?

- Choose PDF file format for printing instead of PNG, JPG, or other image formats.
- If the printing is still not clear, follow the steps to increase the printing darkness/density and adjust the printing speed.
- Carbon accumulation on the print head will also cause the printed labels to be unclear. Follow the steps in the Maintenance section and clean the print head regularly.

10. HOW DO I ADJUST THE DARKNESS OF THE PRINTING AND THE PRINTER'S SPEED?

For Windows:

- Type 'Printer' in the search bar and select 'Printers & Scanners'.
- · Locate the WHTP203e icon and click on it.
- · Choose 'Manage', then 'Printing Preferences'.
- Find 'Print Density' and adjust as needed.
- Light to Dark Density is a scale from 1-15.
- Depending on the quality of the label and thickness, you may need to adjust the density/darkness accordingly.

- To change the darkness of the printing, go to Options, and select Printer Density. Adjust as needed. The higher the number, the darker the print.
- To change the speed of the printing, go to Options, and select Print Speed. Adjust as needed.

SAFETY

- Avoid bending the power cord excessively or placing objects on it.
- Do not operate the printer if you detect any abnormalities, as these could lead to fire or electric shock.

- Unplug the printer when not in use for extended periods of time.
