
Note:




• Redundant screws can be used as spare screws. (The above pictures are for illustration only and the physical accessories shall govern.)


3. Installation

Installation of base

1. Open the package to take out foams and put them on a flat tabletop.




2. Remove the upper foam cover and put it aside, take out the monitor film bag and put the monitor in the lower foam cover.




3. Insert the base into the support and lock attached 1 screws.



4.Insert the neck into mounting on the back of the monitor and secure the installation by inserting and tightening the 2 BM4*8 screws.




5. Simply hold the stand with hand to stand the monitor upright.



Note: During standing of the whole monitor, do not press the liquid crystal screen with hand to avoid damage to the screen.





Monitor Button Action


М	Open the OSD Menu. Confirm the selection to enter the sub-menu/option.

Explanation of indicators




Indicator light: steady blue indicates that the power supply is normal and the display is running normally. In addition, a steady red light indicates that there is no video source, no horizontal or vertical signal or low voltage is detected. If no indicator is displayed, the server is off. Make sure your computer is turned on and all video cables are fully plugged in or connected.


Cable connection




*The bottom interface configuration at the back of the monitor varies with products.

6. OSD menu

Menu description

- Connect the monitor to a power outlet.
 - 1. Press the Power button on the monitor to turn it on (The indicator will turn blue).
 - 2. Connect the monitor to your device with a HDMI cable or other DP cable to the corresponding input on the monitor. The input source will be automatically.
 - 3. To change between inputs, press the "**E**" button to enter the source menu. Use the "**A**" and "**▼**" buttons to choose the input source between Auto Source, DP, HDMI1 and HDMI2.



Brightness/Contrast

After entering the OSD menu, you can adjust the parameters of image mode, color, game settings, audio settings, input selection, system settings, and information.

7. Basic Troubleshooting

Phenomenon	Troubleshooting
Light out/power indicator light is off	Check whether the display and the socket are well connected to power, and whether the display is in the shutdown mode.
2. Image blurring, over-large, over-small, etc.	Enter the menu" Image Setting" and select" Auto Image Adjust" to automatically adjust the display.(For VGA models only)
3. Image over dark	Enter the menu" Brightness and Contrast" to adjust the brightness and contrast of the display.
4. Display over heat	Leave at least 5cm of distance for ventilation around the display and do not place articles on the display.
5. Dark/ light spots when powering on	This is a normal phenomenon. It is due to the backlight illuminates unevenly at the initial phase of powering on caused by temperature difference. The backlight can illuminates normally after 20 minutes, and then the dark/light spots will be corrected.
6. Image distortion, blinking, shaking	Check computer setting, select the correct resolution and re-adjust the refresh frequency.
7. Power off noise	It is a normal phenomenon caused by display discharging in the process of powering off.
