'BELONGING TO THE HILLS' GSM 2022

McLaren Vale

Story: The word Pertaringa means 'belonging to the hills' in the local Kurna language. Bec's father Geoff Hardy chose this name because the cellar door is located in the foothills of McLaren Vale.



Vintage: Similar to the 2021 vintage, there was good winter rainfall that set up the vines for the growing season ahead. A generally mild during 2020 ensured the vines were off to a fantastic start for the 2021 vintage. The cold and windy conditions during flowering led to poor fruit set so yields were down. The weather throughout the season was mild with no days in January or February above 40°C so the long ripening period ensured great acidity and wine with fantastic intensity. Overall a vintage rated very highly in McLaren Vale.

Winemaking: All parcels were fermented and matured separately and spent 12 months in aged French oak.

Nose: The nose offers elegant and attractive aromas of red berries, plums, white pepper, and black olives.

Palate: The palate is vibrant and complex with red berries and plums, followed by a long, smooth finish.
