## Cabernet Sauvignon 2016

## South Australia

**Story:** They say that a parent doesn't have a favourite child, but Cabernet Sauvignon has always secretly been one of ours!

Vintage: The 2016 vintage was in general very mild with low rainfall. The lack of rain looked like it would result in a quick harvest, but a big downpour in early February made sure the vintage was more evenly spread out. The yields were up on the couple of previous years and the quality is looking great.

**Nose:** The nose displays beautifully complex notes of plums, blackberries and cassis with hints of violets.

**Palate:** The palate is soft and youthful with black fruits and chocolate mint, complemented by a well-integrated tannin structure.

Pairing: This is the perfect wine for a lamb on the spit or any other meaty main course!
