Story: Fresh and fruity with a gentle fizz, perfect for the warm summer months or simply because you like the sweeter things in life!

Vintage: Early winter in 2014 was wetter than usual and the period from August to early January was very dry with above average temperatures. Following some rain and milder temperatures in January, the 2015 harvest started later that month and was quite condensed, resulting in some fabulous wines.

Nose: The nose offers aromas of rock melon, passionfruit and kiwi, with hints of honeysuckle and peach blossom.

Palate: The palate is crisp and fresh with notes of lemon, key lime and kiwi fruit. The palate's sweetness is beautifully balanced with great acidity.

Pairing: A perfect wine for any time of the day, from breakfast with your Eggs Benedict, served over ice on a hot day after mowing the lawn or served with a light dessert such as pavlova with strawberries and cream.
