Acknowledging the very best site, climate, vines and production techniques, this Shiraz is named Over the Top to proudly declare our aim to make the finest wine we possibly can.

Vintage

Above average rainfall in the winter set the vines up with healthy canopies. In December some rain helped brighten up the vines and from then on the grapes ripened perfectly. The crops were balanced with winemakers being able to pick their fruit at hearts desire. The wines emerging from 2010 red varieties were of particularly high standard.

Nose

The nose is ripe with red fruit, strawberry and dark plum aromas. More savoury aromas of liquorice and black pepper perfectly balance out the fruity intensity.

Palate

The palate is intense with black cherry, pepper and cigar box aromas. 20 months in fine-grained French oak adds structure and powdery, rich tannins that will see this wine age well into the next decade.

**Pairing** 

Go retro and bring out the carpet bag steak! For you younger ones, that's a scotch fillet steak stuffed with freshly shucked oysters and wrapped in bacon.
