Rifle & Hunt 2013 Cabernet Sauvignon

Story: Rifle and Hunt sounds like the beginning of a tale from an early hunting expedition, but the story is really not that complicated. It's more like directions rather than a name, with the Pertaringa property being on the corner of Rifle Range and Hunt Roads in McLaren Vale!

Vintage: The conditions throughout summer in South Australia were ideal for highlighting the sensational quality this state is capable of producing. The 2013 vintage was low yielding, resulting in exceptional wines with great intensity.

Nose: The nose offers aromas of blackcurrant, mulberries and mint with hints of spice.

Palate: The palate is refined and elegant with blackcurrant, violets and herbaceous notes followed by rich and well-integrated tannins.

Pairing: Try with slow cooked lamb shanks with truffle-infused polenta.

Cellaring: Drink now to 2025
