Rifle & Hunt 2015 Cabernet Sauvignon

Adelaide

Story: Rifle and Hunt sounds like the beginning of a tale from an early hunting expedition, but the story is really not that complicated. It's more like directions rather than a name, with the Pertaringa property being on the corner of Rifle Range and Hunt Roads in McLaren Vale!

Vintage: Early winter in 2014 was wetter than usual and the period from August to early January was very dry with above average temperatures. Following some rain and milder temperatures in January, the 2015 harvest started later that month and was quite condensed, resulting in some fabulous white and red wines.

Nose: The nose is beautifully clean with notes of mint, blackcurrants, cherry tomatoes, pepper and smoky tobacco.

Palate: The palate is smooth and complex with blackcurrants, blueberries, eucalyptus and coffee, followed by a long finish and firm tannins.

Pairing: Try with slow cooked lamb shanks with truffle-infused polenta.

Cellaring: Drink now to 2027
