Each vintage, the Sauvignon Blanc grapes are the first grapes to ripen in the vineyard. The scarecrow is still used as an effective deterrent to the local grapeloving birds and has also lent its name to our famous Sauvignon Blanc.

Vintage

The 2013 vintage was another condensed one with low yields and excellent quality grapes.

Nose

Tropical aromas of granadilla, passionfruit and guava, as well as Granny Smith apple and gooseberries.

Palate

Passionfruit, melon and slightly greener notes of freshly cut grass with fresh, zingy acidity.

Pairing

Grilled Moreton Bay bug tails with fresh garden salad and lime and black pepper aioli.
