Vintage

The 2012 vintage was dry and conditions during ripening were excellent, with mild days and cool to cold nights ensuring good acidity in the fruit. The generally lower crop potential and large canopies resulted in rapid ripening in early varieties and some of the best quality fruit for a number of years.

Nose

Fruity aromas of bright red cherry and rich black forest cake, which is beautifully balanced by spicy aromas of Chinese five spice and star anise.

Palate

The palate is well-balanced with an explosion of cherries and blueberries, followed by a soft finish and integrated tannins.

Crispy pork belly with a black vinegar, pomegranate and star anise glaze served with wild rice, Asian mushrooms and Chinese broccoli.
