Named in recognition of McLaren Vale's history of supplying other regions with our finest red grapes. Known as the mid palate of Australia, McLaren Vale fruit is well regarded for its ability to improve the quality and richness of wines from other regions.

Vintage

A cool, wet vintage throughout most of South Australia, but McLaren Vale faired quite well being a lower rainfall area. The resultant Shiraz from 2011 is more elegant with spicy notes.

Nose

The nose exhibits beautiful aromas of plum, black liquorice, tar, raw cocoa and vanilla bean.

Palate

A rich and smooth palate with black pepper and cloves. It's well-balanced with great structure and plush tannins.

Pairing

Venison loin dry rubbed with juniper berry and lavender. Serve on braised cabbage with a blueberry and red wine glaze.
