Story: No second fiddle, the Understudy is a stylistic contrast to our Rifle & Hunt Cabernet.

Vintage: The conditions throughout summer in McLaren Vale were ideal for highlighting the sensational quality this wine region is capable of producing. The 2013 vintage was low yielding, resulting in exceptional wines with great intensity.

Nose: Dense aromas of blackberries and sweet black plum are complemented by hints of dried herbs and lavender.

Palate: The palate is well-balanced with cassis and greener herbaceous notes, followed by broad and grippy tannins that will soften with time.

Pairing: Try with a marinated lamb and chargrilled vegetable pizza with goat cheese and rosemary.
