









Find Your Child's Size

- 1. Print this measuring guide on a sheet of 8.5" x 11" paper. Print the guide at 100% (uncheck "Page Scaling" on your print settings).
- 2. Have your child stand on this paper with his or her heel against the HEEL line. Encourage them to put their weight on the foot and relax their toes for an accurate measurement.
- 3. Draw a line to mark the end of the longest toe. If your child is between sizes, round up.
- 4. Repeat the process with the other foot. You may want to select a slightly larger size to allow for growing feet.
