Accuracy Check

To ensure correct printing size, place a credit card here. If the card fits, the scale is correct.

What you'll need:

- book
- pencil
- hard floor
- 1 barefoot child
- sharp eyes
- credit card (for print scale)

1 Print this page

Print this on an 8.5"x11" piece of paper at 100% scale. Be sure printing options are NOT set to "Fit to Page" check print accuracy with the tool above.

2 Align your child's foot

Place one foot on the size chart, aligning heel with curved line. It helps to place a book or hard object on the line. Mark the first visible line past longest toe with pencil. Make sure your child is barefoot and is putting weight on the foot being measured.

3 Measure the other foot

Now measure of the other foot. Make sure to go with the size of the longer foot!

4 Ideal fit

Kamik shoes and boots are made to correctly fit according to the measurement provided. Buy the number you see here!

- A child's foot can grow up to a half size every three months, so be sure to re-measure every two months.
