

Damaging product by altering, bending, drilling, subjecting to chemical corrosion or wet /dry fire will void product warranty.


STEPS FOR A SUCCESSFUL INSTALLATION

- 1. Read through complete instructions before performing work.
- 2. Inspect for shipping/handling damage. **Do Not install a product that appears to be damaged.**
- **3.** Using the data label, confirm the new element has the same kW value as the element being removed.
 - **➡** Stop and contact your element supplier if you have the incorrect part.
- **4.** Turn spa thermostat to the "OFF" position and shut power "OFF" at spa breaker. Drain spa water or isolate the heater plumbing so spa water will not drain.
- **<u>5.</u>** Remove the bad element and note direction of the high limit switch and location of wire connections.
- <u>7.</u> Clean and inspect heater housing O-ring surface, nuts, washers, bolts, and high limit devices to be reused.



- **8.** Install element and tighten mounting bolts in a harmonic pattern until O-ring is compressed (O-ring lube recommended).
- 9. Reconnect wires to element terminals using a backup wrench to prevent damage to terminals (Ref DIA #2).
- **10.** Jumper wire "A" replaces the metal bridge connectors.
- **11.** Install threaded plug or bolt depending on heater model. Provided plugs have dry sealant applied to threads.
- **12.** Complete installation, refill spa, turn on breaker, and inspect for leaks with pump at high speed.







WARNING! Never allow the element/heater to operate without water flow
