

## Build a Bird Bath

Fun Fact! Bumblebees may use your bird bath to have a drink in too.



Birds that visit your garden often need feeding but they also need a drink or bath too! You can buy ready-made bird baths, but you may have things laying around that will do the job...




## You will need:

- A shallow watertight bowl like a plant pot tray or old dustbin lid (maximum depth of 10cm)
- Some stones or gravel
- Bricks for if your bowl doesn't have a base
- Rain or tap water


Step 3 - Fill your bird bath with water. Rainwater is ideal - but tap water is another alternative.

Step 1 - If your bowl doesn't have a flat base, lay four bricks on the ground where you would like your bird bath to be, then put your bowl on top of the bricks, making sure it's stable.



Step 2 - Place pebbles, stones, or rocks in the water to give your birds a resting place and escape route.





Step 5 - Sit back and enjoy the wildlife drinking bird bath!
