INTRODUCTION

This manual covers the operator accessible service mode features, options (also called "modes") settings and diagnostic/data logs.

The FLEX controller hardware utilizes a 3.5 inch screen, as a key feature visible from the outside of the vending machine. Optional hardware features include a 10" iCart touch screen.

SERVICE MODE


Use **Service Mode** to program and change settings. Use the keypad as an input device and watch the display for information while performing Service Mode functions.

SERVICE MODE BUTTON

To enter **Service Mode**, press the **Service Mode Button** located in the lower left hand corner of the control board. See figure 1. To exit Service Mode, press the Service Mode Button again or press the key 3 times.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

If no key is pressed for approximately 1 minute while in **Service Mode**, the controller will automatically return to **Sales Mode**.





KEYPAD


To program the vendor, use the buttons on the keypad to navigate as directed in the instructions below.

Buttons 2, **8**, **4**, **6**, **#** and ***** are used to move between the various modes, menus and submenus; 2=Move Up; 8=Move Down, 4=Move Left; 6=Move Right; **#**=Enter; *****=Go Back/Escape See Figure 2.

Important Note: The FLEX controller does not utilize a **TUBE FILL MODE**; the controller uses the tube amounts that are reported by the coin changer.

PRICE MENU

The **Set Price** menu allows three (3) methods for assigning prices:

- ALL ITEMS.
- · RANGE OF ITEMS.
- INDIVIDUAL ITEM

The maximum price that can be set is \$655.35.

SET PRICE ALL ITEMS

This menu allows you to set the selection price of every item in the machine at the same time.


Time Saving Tip: Use the all items option to set the most common price in the machine; then go back and set the different price of each item or row.

Resettable totals: These are totals since the last reset. These can be reset at any time.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Clearing by item or range will only clear the item or range entered.
