# RULES

## WHAT'S IN THE BOX

The box contains 75 Word Cue Cards, 2 Dry-Erase Score Boards, 4 Dry-Erase Slates, 4 Dry-Erase Markers with Erasers, and Rules.

## OBJECTIVE

Outscore the other team as you and your partner attempt to finish the Word Cues with the same answers. Together, you have 10 rounds to score as many points as possible to claim victory.

## HOW TO PLAY

1. All players need a slate and dry-erase marker. Give each team a score board.
2. Choose either the light or dark side of the cards to play with. Place the first Word Cue face up on the table. Read it aloud. Players will secretly write two answers to fill in the blank on their slates. *Hint: To score the most points, put the word you are most confident you will make a match with in the top space.*

### Filling In The Blanks

There are just a few small guidelines for what counts as acceptable answers:

- Both compound words and two-word phrases are acceptable.
- Proper nouns are acceptable, as long as you still write just one word.
- Adding a syllable is okay if you can still hear the root word.
- Single-letter additions are a no no!

Once everyone has written down two answers, reveal the words.

3. A total of 10 points are available to each team. Tally up the scores for each team accordingly.

### Each player on a team scores:

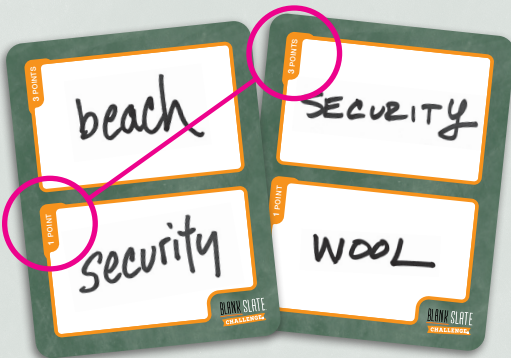
- **3 points** if their **top word** matches either word of their teammate.
- **1 point** if their **bottom word** matches either word of their teammate.
- **0 points** for **unmatched words**.
- **2 additional bonus points** if **both words** match and are **in the same order**.

Write your team's total score for the round on your score board.

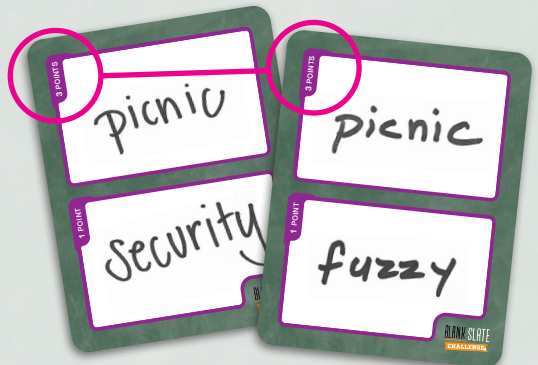
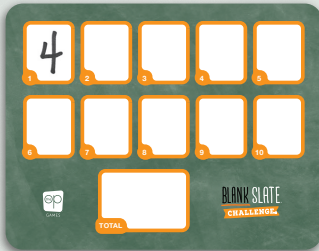
4. Continue flipping the top Word Cue card and writing answers for 10 rounds.

**After 10 rounds, the team with the most points wins!**

**Example:** Team A scores 4 points for matching on the word SECURITY.  
Team B scores 6 points, because they both wrote PICNIC in the top space.  
Even though one of the players on Team B also wrote SECURITY, matches are only scored when a player matches with their teammate.
