

MASTER TOOL SELF-CENTERING GUIDE FOR PUNCHES

Congratulations on your purchase of the Master Tool Self-Centering Guide for Punches. This guide allows you to center holes and maintain consistent spacing between holes. This guide works best with Master Tool Punches, accommodating Master Tool Round Punches in sizes 2-8 and Master Tool Oval Punches in sizes 5-8.

INSTRUCTIONS

1) Mark the first and second hole on your strap using a scratch awl. Figures 1 & 2



 Position the first hole on your strap with the guide hole on the jig, making sure the guide is positioned as shown in the image. Figure 3







- 3) Insert your Master Tool Hole Punch through the hole on the guide. Figure 4
- 4) Punch through the leather using a mallet. Figure 5

- 5) Move the strap so the second marked hole is even with the hole in the guide. Loosen the wire guide and position it at the center of the first hole. **Figure 6**
- 6) Punch your second hole using the hole punch and guide.
- 7) Move your strap so the wire guide is centered on the second punched hole. This will help you maintain the same distance between the next holes you punch. **Figure 7**




