

Wall Mounted LCD TV Installation Guide

Tools Required

- 1200mm level
- Drill
- Drill bit
- Eye protection
- Pencil
- Phillips head screwdriver
- Ratchet spanner
- Shifting spanner
- Stud finder
- Tape measure
- Mounting bracket
- Television

Installation Process

1. Find studs in the wall

TVs are heavy, so mount yours on a stud for security. Use an electronic stud finder or tap the wall—studs sound solid. Mark their spots with a pencil.

2. Line up your wall mount bracket

Line up the TV bracket (like the Crest Large Full Motion Mount) with the studs. Know your TV's size and weight before choosing a bracket. Use the built-in spirit level to ensure it's straight, then mark where you'll drill.

3. Drill your holes

Drill pilot holes at your pencil marks. Fix the bolts into the wall, but leave them a little loose to adjust later.

4. Attach brackets to your TV

Fix the hanging brackets to the back of your TV carefully—don't overtighten.

5. Grab a friend to help

Lifting the TV alone isn't safe. Get help, lift it into place, adjust for glare if needed, and tighten the bottom screws securely.

6. Wipe it down

Clean off fingerprints with a cloth, plug it in, and you're ready to enjoy!

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
