When, a few minutes later, the body of a Russian national is found in a container at Maisonneuve Terminal, the authorities surmise that this is no accident \mathcal{E} and that the city's fireworks are just beginning.

In Quebec City, Detective Xavier Martel is called on to figure out why the man in the container was headed to the Port of Montreal. The authorities are worried because the body bears an unusual tattoo, raising fears that a nightmarish drug has arrived in the country: Krokodil.

Dirty money, human trafficking, pitiless acts of violence, betrayals: is Xavier Martel's autumn in fact going to be worse than already expected?
