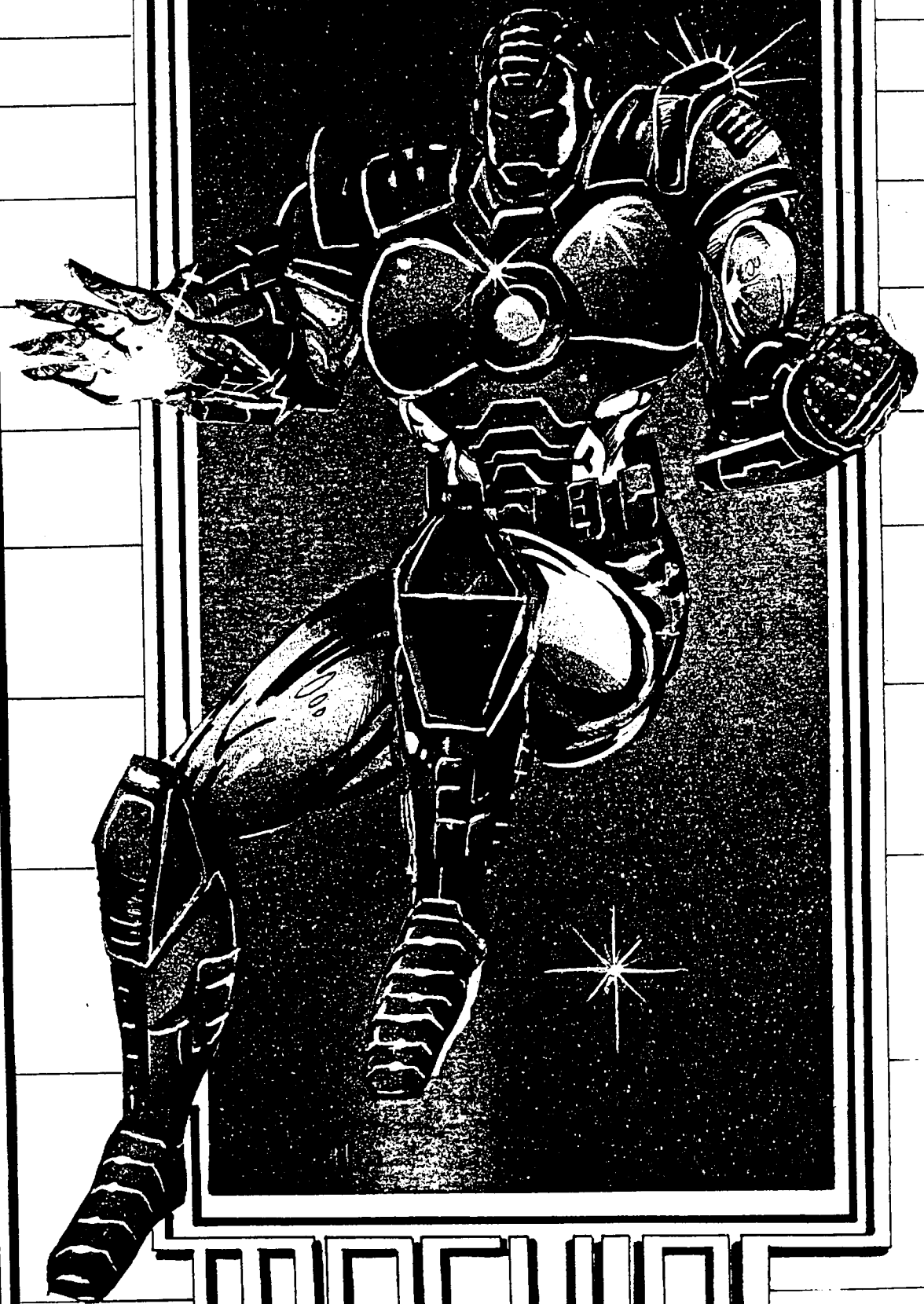

War Machine appears along with some of Marvel's other heavy hitters.

Sentry, wearing a modified Guardsmen suit, sets out with his "Jury" to bring Spidey to justice!

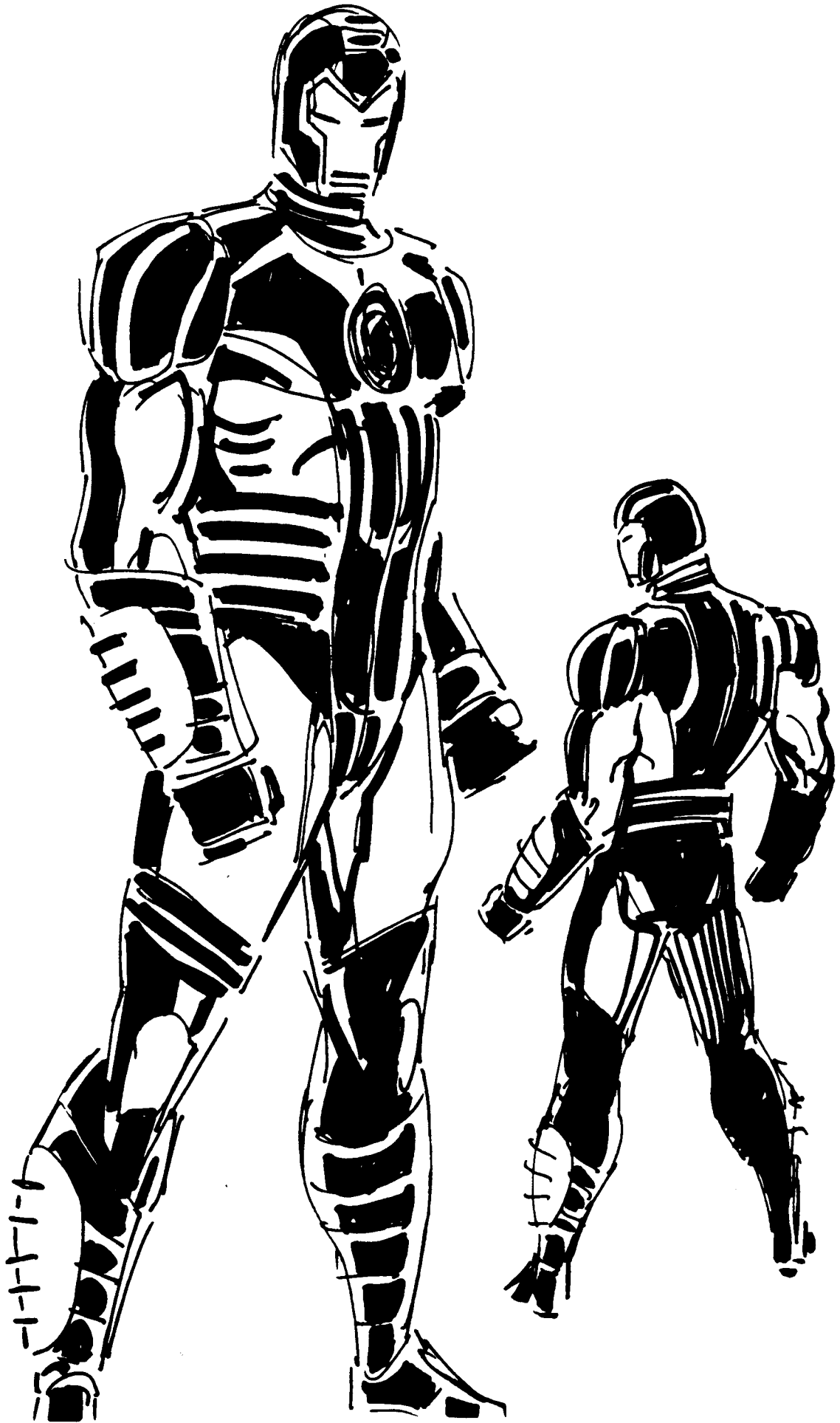


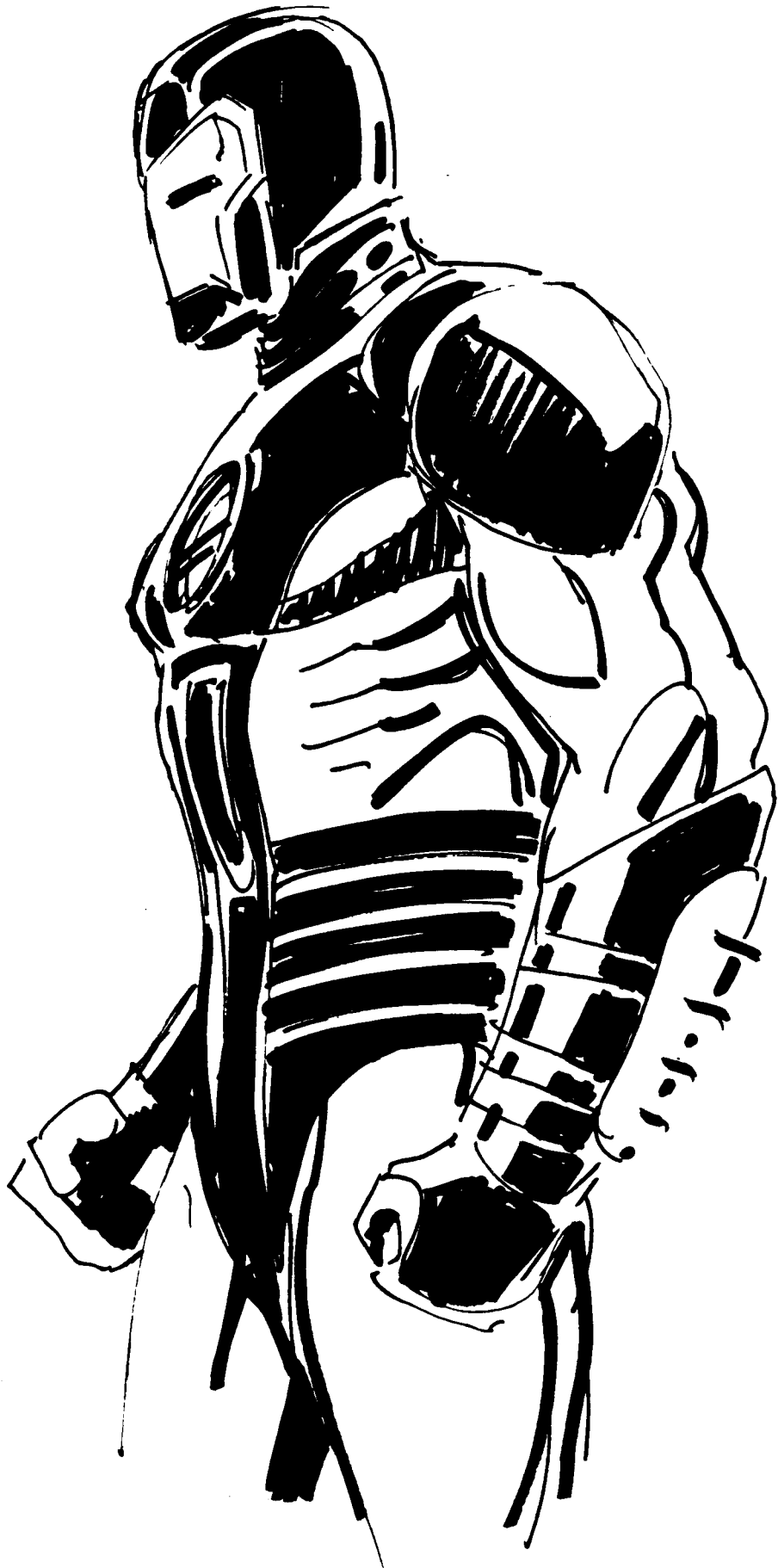
DETAIL OF
