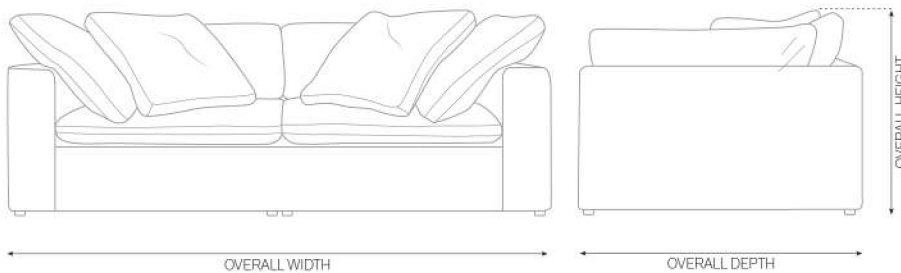
- As part of our commitment to ensuring a seamless and safe delivery experience for your furniture, we would like to provide you with some important instructions based on the lift measurements process.

MEASURE THE PATH FOR DELIVERY

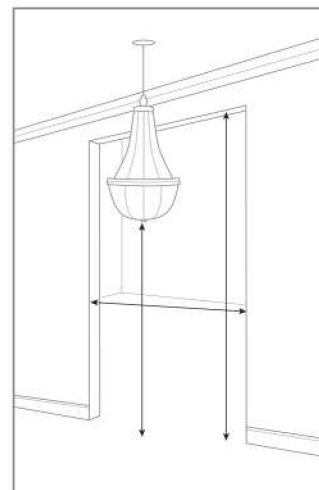
Find the optimal route from the exterior of your home to the specific room where you intend to place your furniture. Take measurements of all doorways, elevators, staircases, and hallways that the item will need to pass through. For apartment buildings or homes with elevators, it's crucial to measure the elevator interior height, elevator opening, and distance to the opposite wall. Additionally, measure entry clearances (the space between the doorway and the opposite wall) in case the furniture needs to navigate a corner. Compare these measurements with the dimensions of your new furniture to ensure that our delivery professionals can maneuver through entryways and around any obstacles.

MEASURE THE SPACE WHERE YOUR FURNITURE WILL LIVE

Ensure that you determine the placement of your furniture. Verify the width, depth, and height of the item on our website to ensure it will fit in your chosen space. You may also want to consider creating a floorplan to scale, or using painter's tape to mark out the width and depth of your furniture on the floor.

Please be advised that our delivery professionals are unable to relocate existing furniture within your home, handle electrical equipment installation, or remove doors from their hinges. Prior to the arrival of our delivery team, please ensure the following preparations are made:

Clear a pathway by moving any obstructing furniture or artwork

Secure any low-hanging light fixtures

Keep pets confined to another room It is your responsibility to confirm that all furniture items can pass through access points such as doorways, stairways, hallways, elevators, and around corners to reach the desired location.
