



## **Install the Fixture**



- I Secure the mounting plate to the junction box.
- 2 Connect the fixture to a suitable ground in accordance with local electrical codes.
- 3 Connect the white fixture wire to the neutral power line wire with a wire nut.
- 4 Connect the black fixture wire to the hot power line wire with a wire nut.
- Neatly tuck the wiring into the junction box, place the fixture base onto the mounting plate and secure it in place with fixture screws.
- 6 Screw the lamps into the sockets. Refer to the label on the socket for max wattage information.
- 7 Place the shade top onto the shade.
- Align the studs on the shade with the holes on the fixture base, then secure them together using the cap nuts.
