

The Glancy Wine Education Fund Background & Donation Information 2017

The Background

At San Francisco Wine School, we believe that every motivated and engaged student should have access to high quality, professional education in his or her trade. Sadly, many jobs in hospitality and the wine industry pay well below equivalent positions in other industries and those truly passionate about their field, cannot afford the education they need to begin or advance their careers. Since our inception in 2011, we have been funding our own tuition assistance programs as well as providing flexible financing and internships to worthy recipients. As the offerings and awareness of our school have expanded, the financial need of deserving students has outpaced our ability to serve, so in 2017, the 5013c qualified Glancy Wine Education Fund was established to provide scholarships to San Francisco Wine School Students in search of financial aid. Our inaugural scholarship cycle this summer revealed an incredible need in our community and we are endeavoring to raise \$100,000 or more to support the tuition of up-and-coming professionals in need.

The Fund

The 501c3-qualified Glancy Wine Education Fund was established in 2017 with a \$50,000 contribution from the proceeds of San Francisco Wine School's 2016 Anniversary Celebration & Scholarship Auction and generous contributions from community donors. This fund allowed us to greatly expand our ability to provide tuition assistance to those in need by awarding educational scholarships for any certification program offered by San Francisco Wine School to students demonstrating financial need and relevant educational and professional goals in the wine and hospitality industry.

Scholarship recipients are evaluated and ranked by an independent committee based on financial need, academic performance, and work experience, as well as educational and career goals. Scholarships are awarded based on the cost of coursework requested and the amount available in the Fund.

The Need

The Fund's inaugural scholarship cycle this last August revealed a much greater need than expected. In only *three weeks*, the GWEF received *60 applications* with requests totaling *over* \$100,000. We were also shocked to learn that 97% of the completed applications were from students earning less than the "living wage" threshold in our community. As a result, the fund was able to provide *awards to only 40% of the qualified applicants before completely depleting the available funds.*

This year, we are determined to raise even more funds to support financially challenged students in our community who are eager to start or advance their career in wine and service. 2018 scholarships will be funded with profits from San Francisco Wine School's 2017 Anniversary Celebration and Scholarship Auction being held Saturday, October 21st from 1-6pm and from generous donations from the wine industry businesses, professionals, and enthusiasts in our community. All contributions to the Glancy Wine Education Fund will be tax deductible.

The Impact of Donations

- \$25,000 will fund an entry level certification program to a class of students preparing for their first sommelier exams
- \$15,000 will provide 2 students with the education they need to prepare for advanced level sommelier or Certified Wine Educator Exams and industry competitions
- \$10,000 will help 3 Chefs, Event Planners, Waiters, or Managers of Restaurants, Wine Bars, & Tasting Rooms to understand global wines, service and food pairing in a way that impacts their staff and improves the service of their clients
- \$5,000 will provide 1 entry level sommelier with the education they need to prepare for intermediate level exams and competitions
- \$1,500 will help a student get the education they need to prepare for an entry level job in the wine industry
- \$800 will help a Wine Program Manager or Director get the education they need to make their beverage lists creative, diversified and profitable
