

#### GENERAL CARE

- · All products are designed for indoor use and intended purposes.
- · Armrests and backrests are not designed as seating.
- · Alternate choice of seat regularly for an even wearing process.
- · Fabric may stretch over time, this is natural with regular use.
- · Attend to stains immediately.
- · Always follow manufacturer care instructions.
- · Always spot test any cleaning method in an inconspicuous area.
- · Never use heat as this can set the stains.
- Several light applications of a cleaning agent are less harmful than a single concentrated application. Repeat stain treatment several times if necessary.
- · Do not use products containing bleach.
- · Cleaning instructions included in this guide refer to water based stains (wine, soft drink).
- Any oil based stains (food, makeup, crayons) will require dry cleaning.
   We recommend seeking professional advice as certain chemicals can irreversibly damage our fabrics.
- · For added protection, anti-stain products / repellents can be applied.
- Pilling is a natural occurrence caused by normal wear.

  This can be removed with a handheld de-pilling machine.
- Pilling may reappear, this becomes less likely over time with regular de-pilling.



### MINA

- · Do not bleach.
- · Do not iron.
- · Do not tumble dry.
- · Try to avoid direct sunlight, to prevent fading.
- · Wrinkles can be removed with a light steam.
- Gently vacuum with an upholstery attachment regularly to prevent build up.
- · Treat stains immediately.
- · Soak up any excess liquid using a clean, dry cloth.
- Use warm water, some mild soap can be added if needed.
- Gently apply solution to affected area and use a light dabbing motion to lift the stain out.
- Do not saturate the area.
- · Avoid rubbing as this can damage the fabric.
- · Allow to air dry.
- · For stubborn stains, professional cleaning is recommended.



### SIENA

- · Do not bleach.
- · Do not iron.
- Do not tumble dry.
- · Delicate dry clean.
- · Try to avoid direct sunlight, to prevent fading.
- · Wrinkles can be removed with a light steam.
- Gently vacuum with an upholstery attachment regularly to prevent build up.
- · Treat stains immediately.
- · Soak up any excess liquid using a clean, dry cloth.
- · Use warm water, some mild soap can be added if needed.
- Gently apply solution to affected area and use a light dabbing motion to lift the stain out.
- Do not saturate the area.
- · Avoid rubbing as this can damage the fabric.
- · Allow to air dry.
- · For stubborn stains, professional cleaning is recommended.



### OPAL

- Do not bleach.
- · Do not iron.
- · Do not tumble dry.
- · Try to avoid direct sunlight, as velvet is sensitive to colour fading.
- · Pressure marks will usually recover over time.
- More stubborn marks can be removed with vacuuming or some light steam and a gentle brush.
- · Heavy traffic areas can be vacuumed with an upholstery attachment regularly to maintain the pile.
- · Steam regularly on a low setting to restore compressed pile.
- · Treat stains immediately.
- · Soak up any excess liquid using a clean, dry cloth.
- Using soapy water and a lint free cloth, dip the cloth in the suds only and lightly blot the area.
- Do not apply too much pressure and avoid scratching or rubbing, this can damage the weave.
- Do not saturate the area.
- · Allow to air dry.
- · Softly brush the area after cleaning to prevent matting and restore the loft.
- · For stubborn stains, professional cleaning is recommended.



### COPENHAGEN

- · Do not bleach.
- · Do not iron.
- · Do not tumble dry.
- Gently vacuum with an upholstery attachment regularly to prevent build up. Take care not to drag the vacuum, instead place it down in sections to avoid pulling the fabric.
- · Treat stains immediately.
- · Soak up any excess liquid using a clean, dry cloth.
- · For water based stains, use a water based cleaner e.g soapy water
- Gently apply solution to affected area and use a light dabbing motion to lift the stain out.
- Do not saturate the area.
- · Avoid rubbing as this can damage the loops of fabric.
- · Allow to air dry.
- · For stubborn stains, professional cleaning is recommended.
