## NOTES FROM THE ARRANGER

Charles Gounod's opera *Faust* is based on Goethe's play *Faust*; its French libretto is by Jules Barbier and Michel Carré. In the opera, before young Valentin leaves for war, he sings *Avant de quitter ces lieux*, petitioning God to protect his sister in his absence. Valentin's heartfelt prayer abounds with conflicting emotions: he cares earnestly for his sister's safety, yet is eager to defend his homeland and seek glory in battle. Singers should consider the devotional, yet enthusiastic text and operatic style of the music when performing.
