

PERFORMANCE NOTES

"It's the Hard-Knock Life," from the musical, "Annie," tells of the hardships endured by the children living in a depression-era orphanage. It's one of the most famous songs from the musical. Annie and the children sing the song as they clean their room all night, a punishment received for trying to escape the orphanage.

CHORAL PREPARATION

Perform the song with great energy and a sense of urgency. To highlight the intensity, accent the quarter notes in the opening theme (meas. 4-23). In meas. 24-40 and 60-76, however, sing with a *legato* style as a contrast to the deliberately accented phrases.

There are several film versions of "Annie" available for viewing. This arrangement mirrors the original film from 1982.
