



Washing wool cheat sheet

- Fleece is well skirted and pulled apart
- fiber is bagged up into laundry bags (nice and even so water can penetrate wool)
- sink or tubs filled with hot water
- add soap (add soap first so you don't get bubbles)
 - **Wash #1** - place fiber in tubs/sink and poke them down with a dowel so they are submerged
 - soak for 25-30 min
- **Wash #2** -drain/spin fiber. Refill with hot water and add soap
- . Let soak for 25-30 min
- **Rinse #1** -drain/spin fiber.
- You should hear the soap bubbles crackle.
- Refill with hot water. No soap! Poke them so submerged
- let soak for 25-30 minutes
- **Rinse #2** -drain/spin fiber.
- Place fiber in tubs and poke them down with a dowel so they are submerged
- soak for 25-30 min
- Once the fiber is drained or spun and you don't hear soap suds lay the fiber out to dry. If you hear soap give them an extra rinse.
