Building code performance clauses

B2 Durability

B2.3.1

Building elements must, with only normal maintenance, continue to satisfy the performance requirements of this code for the lesser of the specified intended life of the building, if stated, or:

- (c) 5 years if: the building elements (including services, linings, renewable protective coatings, and fixtures) are easy to access and replace, and failure of those building elements to comply with the building code would be easily detected during normal use of the building.

F2 Hazardous building materials

F2.3.1

The quantities of gas, liquid, radiation or solid particles emitted by materials used in the construction of buildings, shall not give rise to harmful concentrations at the surface of the material where the material is exposed, or in the atmosphere of any space.

G1 Personal Hygiene

G1 Personal Hygiene

G1.3.2

Sanitary fixtures shall be located, constructed and installed to:

1. facilitate sanitation,
2. avoid risk of food contamination,
3. avoid harbouring dirt or germs,
4. provide appropriate privacy,
5. avoid affecting occupants of adjacent spaces from the presence of unpleasant odours, accumulation of offensive matter, or other source of annoyance,
6. allow effective cleaning,
7. discharge to a plumbing and drainage system as required by Clause G13 Foul water when water-borne disposal is used, and
8. provide a healthy safe disposal system when non-water-borne disposal is used.

G12 Water Supplies

G12.3.2

A potable water supply system must be—

1. protected from contamination; and
2. installed in a manner that avoids the likelihood of contamination within the system and the water main; and
3. installed using components that will not contaminate the water.
