EMERGENCY TARP MULTI-USE 4 SEASON

HOW TO USE IT

 Choose a safe location and lay out the tarp. The addition of an insulating mattress and an empty backpack will provide more comfort for the victim.

Skis can be placed inside for added rigidity but are not necessary and may damage the lightweight tarp.

Tip: Protect the edges well with the climbing skins.


- Place the victim in the middle of the tarp and close it using the velcro, leaving an opening for the face.
- Pass the red cordolette in the **small red** eyelets like you would lace a shoe, through the bottom. See illustration.

Tip: It is also possible to use ski straps (64cm to 90 cm) to secure the victim and close the tarp;

- Cut the **4mm cordolette** in sevral sections as required by your hauling plan.
- Install the traction system by passing a section of the 4mm cordolette through the two front vellow loops.
- Install the rear stabilization system by passing a second section of 4mm rope through the two rear yellow strap loops.
- If you need to sidehill, install the Lateral stability loop balancing system as shown on the right.

The tarp can also be used as an emergency bivy or survival blanket with its velcro closure.

WARNINGS

WHEN EVACUATING IN EXTREME TERRAIN: SECURE the victim with appropriate equipment to restrain the victim in case of traction system failure.

DO NOT use the red eyelets or blue handles for traction.

THIS IS AN EMERGENCY TARP MADE OF FABRIC. Using it on abrasive surfaces, rocks or over branches can damage like the fabric and even tear it.
