Baileys of Glenrowan is one of the pioneers of winemaking in North-East Victoria, producing its first vintage in 1870. Since this time, the region has become world-renowned winemaking region. Baileys of Glenrowan continues to be recognised today as a world-class producer of full-flavoured red and luscious fortified wines.

This VP140 is a modern take on the traditional Australian fortifieds, created from a selection of premium sourced Portuguese grape varieties, that are blended with Shiraz as a nod to our heritage. This produces a vintage fortified that celebrates over 140 years of history and winemaking craftsmanship.

VINTAGE CONDITIONS

An even growing season without any heat spikes allowed fruit to ripen slowly and be harvest at peak timing. Vines were well balanced also delivering ideal conditions for fruit to naturally vine ripen.

WINEMAKING & MATURATION

Made in open fermenters and fortified with a specially selected spirit, maturation in stainless steel and in bottle.

TASTING NOTES

Ripe, luscious and aromatic. Dens liquorice and aniseed, rich and soft with tight tannis, intens drive and great ageing potential.

ANALYSIS

Alc/Vol 18.2% T.A 5.02g/L pH 3.80

PEAK DRINKING

Cellar until 2040.
