Baileys of Glenrowan continues to be recognised as an acclaimed producer of full-flavoured red and luscious fortified wines.

Our Small Batch Series is crafted as the best expression of the unique landscape and climate of our Bundarra vineyard, planted over ancient red granite soils. These wines are produced organically to showcase the diversity of varietals in the region.

VINTAGE CONDITIONS

Blessed with a steady vintage, with all varieties ripening in natural order, which gave a well spread intake. This allowed winemakers to dedicate the required time and energy to each parcel maximising the quality.

WINEMAKING & MATURATION

Treated softly in the winery with no crushing, aiming to retain flavour and brightness. Gently pressed to older French oak and some to tank allowing for the complexity of barrel maturation and maximizing juicy freshness retention via tank maturation.

TASTING NOTE

Bright crimson colour with a lifted floral aromatic, immediately awakening the senses. The palate is primary with layers of cherries and blue fruits overlaid with spice and rounded with soft supple tannins and a slight savoury finish.

ANALYSIS

Alc/Vol 13.9% T.A 5.86g/L pH 3.62

PEAK DRINKING

Best consumed whilst young and fresh.

ENJOY

Serve at room temperature or try chilling lightly just before serving. Beautifully accompanies game meats like duck or even succulent pork dishes.
