### 2021 ORGANIC ROSÉ

Baileys of Glenrowan is one of the pioneers of winemaking in North-East Victoria, producing its first vintage in 1870. Since this time, Glenrowan has become a world-renowned winemaking region. Baileys of Glenrowan continues to be recognised as an acclaimed producer of full-flavoured red and luscious fortified wines.

Our Small Batch Series is crafted as the best expression of the unique landscape and climate of our Bundarra vineyard, planted over ancient red granite soils. These wines are produced organically to showcase the diversity of varieties in the region.

#### VINTAGE CONDITIONS

Blessed with a steady vintage, with all varieties ripening in natural order, which gave a balanced spread intake. This allowed winemakers to dedicate the required time and energy to each parcel maximising the quality.

#### WINEMAKING & MATURATION

Gently pressed making sure to only retain the lightly coloured free run, then part fermented in seasoned French oak barrels for complexity and texture and part fermented in tank for vibrancy and freshness..

#### TASTING NOTE

Attractive cherry and raspberry characters on the nose, this rose is dry and shows subtle red fruit flavours on the palate with a savoury finish complemented by chalky fine tannin, making it a perfect food wine.

#### ANALYSIS

Alc/Vol 13.8% T.A 5.63g/L pH 3.35 RS (Glucose & Fructose) Dry

#### PEAK DRINKING

Best consumed whilst young and fresh.

#### ENJOY

Serve chilled with seafood linguine and summer salads.
