# Child's Play® INCLUSION & ACCESSIBILITY

Child's Play aims to reflect our diverse society and challenge stereotypes in everything we publish, and you'll find ethnically diverse characters in all our books. However, diversity and inclusion does not simply refer to heritage and culture, but also to disability, gender, gender identity, sexual preference, socio-economic status and age. Inclusive images are casual and incidental, meaning that all children can see themselves represented equally, rather than singled out for special attention. This leaflet highlights some of the diverse characters that you may be trying to find.











In The Wheels on the Bus there is a character who wears a head scarf and a child with no hair. Another

character drives an adapted toy car. One of the children in Zoom, Zoom, Zoom uses a wheelchair. There is also a child with an eye patch. In Round and Round the Garden there is a child with an arm splint. One of the children in This Little Piggy has vitiligo. In Ten Little Fingers one character wears a headscarf and another wears protective headgear. The group of children in Pat-A-Cake includes a character with Down Syndrome and a character who uses

a hearing aid. Two children wear glasses and one child has an eye patch in Hey Diddle Diddle. Head. Shoulders, Knees and Toes, If You're Happy and You Know It, Pop a Little Pancake and Five Little Ducks contain characters who wear glasses. Children wearing eye patches appear in Head, Shoulders, Knees and Toes and If You're Happy and You Know It. A child wears a hearing aid in Head, Shoulders, Knees and Toes. Down by the Station features a child

wearing a hearing aid while another child signs to them, and there is a child with a birth mark. In Hop A Little there is a child wearing protective headgear and another with no hair. There is also a character with eczema. Row, Row, Row Your Boat features a child with a feeding tube and two characters wearing glasses. A child in Five Enormous Dinosaurs















