
#### TOOLS NEEDED:

- Ratchet - 7/16" Socket - 1/2" Socket
- 9/16" Socket - 7/16" Wrench
- 1/2" Wrench
- 9/16" Wrench - 3/16" Hex Bit Socket
- Phillips Head Screwdriver
- Fender Cover/Towel
- Torque Wrench

We highly recommend a complete installation for test fit prior to paint. The test fit is also important to test for handlebar clearance that may need to be adjusted or replaced.

- 1. Verify all the contents of the Fairing Fit Kit (FIG 1):
  - a. Fairing
  - b. Neck Bracket
  - c. Lower Bracket
  - d. Lower Support
  - e. Fairing Mount Adapter
  - 7" Headlight Mount Ring f.
  - a. Hardware Kit
    - i. Hardware Bag "B" Windshield
    - ii. Hardware Bag "C" 7" Headlight Ring Mount
    - iii. Hardware Bag "D" Fairing to Neck
    - iv. Hardware Bag "E" Lower Support to Fairing
    - v. Hardware Bag "F" Neck to Frame & Lower Bracket
    - vi. Hardware Bag "G" Lower Support to Lower Bracket
  - h. Headlight Cover Kit
    - i. Headlight Cover
    - ii. Headlight Cover Trim
    - iii. Headlight Cover Hardware
    - iv. Headlight Cover Instructions
  - 9" Dark Smoke Flare™ Windshield for FXRP Fairing i.






### INSTRUCTIONS CONTINUED

- 2. Cover the front fender to help protect against damage (FIG 2).
- 3. Remove windshield and fairing if equipped.
- 4. Remove headlight and mount (FIG 3).



- 5. Remove the two front motor mount bolts (FIG 4). Using **Hardware Bag "G"** place the carriage bolt into position and install the **Lower Bracket** reusing OEM hardware. Hardware can be snug, but still allowing adjustments to be made (FIG 5).
- 6. Remove front fuel tank bolt. Using **Hardware Bag "F"**, install the **Neck Bracket** with upper bolt through fuel tank and lower bolt through lower bracket (**FIG 6**). **Neck Bracket** is installed outside of the fuel tank tabs. Hardware can be finger tight for now.



- Using Hardware Bag "D", install the Fairing and Fairing Mount Adapter to the Neck Bracket (FIG 7). Position the Fairing Mount Adapter so the notch is at the 6 o'clock down position (FIG 8). Snug bolts down, still allowing for side-to-side adjustments.
- 8. Using Hardware Bag "F" install the Lower Support using the carriage bolt installed in Step 5. The plates at the ends of the bracket should be inside of the fairing (FIG 9). Using Hardware Bag "E" install the Lower Support to the fairing. Hardware can be finger tight for now.

## INSTRUCTIONS CONTINUED

- 9. Tighten all loosely installed hardware in order below to torque values listed.
  - a. Hardware Bag "G" 3/8" hardware Lower Bracket to Lower Support 18 ft-lbs.
  - b. Tighten Motor Mount Bolts to Factory Specs.
  - c. Hardware Bag "F" 5/16" hardware Neck Bracket 13 ft-lbs.
  - d. Hardware Bag "E" 1/4" hardware Lower Support to Fairing 45 in-lbs.
  - e. Hardware Bag "D" 3/8" hardware Fairing to Neck 18 ft-lbs.



- Using Hardware Bag "C" install 7" Headlight Ring Mount to Fairing Mount Adapter positioning the threaded tab at 6 o'clock down and torquing to 45 in-lbs (FIG 10). If not using trim ring, remove screw from threaded tab.
- Remove headlight retaining ring, install headlight and reinstall retaining ring (FIG 11).
  NOTE: Headlight adjustment screws with springs may require thread locking compound after adjustments are made.
- Using Hardware Bag "B" insert the seven well nuts and install the provided 9" Dark Smoke Flare<sup>®</sup>. Torque to 10 in-lbs (FIG 12).
- 13. Refer to instructions in FXR Fairing Headlight Cover Kit (white box) for Cover install.
