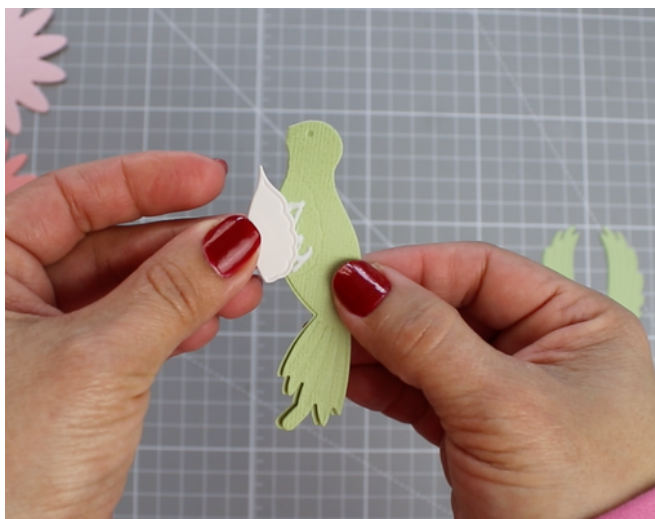




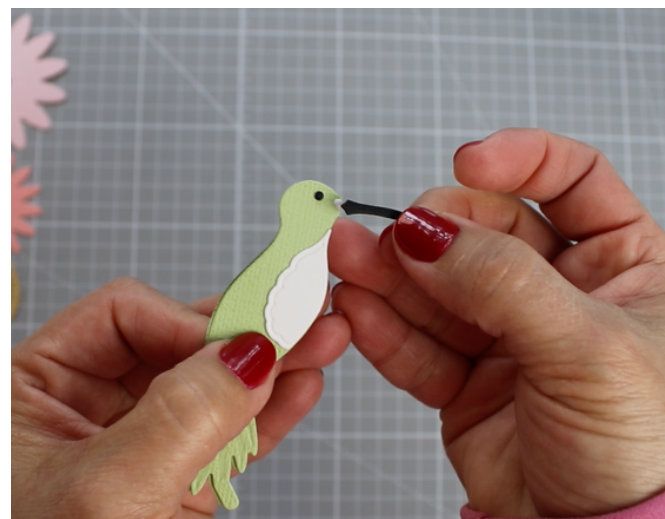
POP-UP HUMMINGBIRD



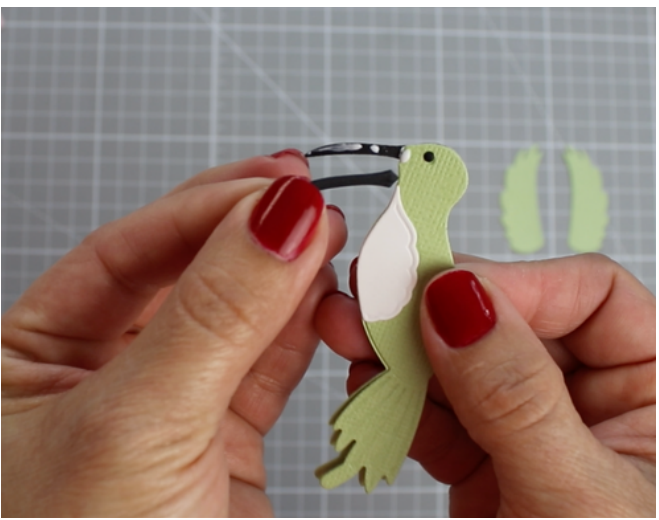
1. Fold the hummingbird die-cut in half



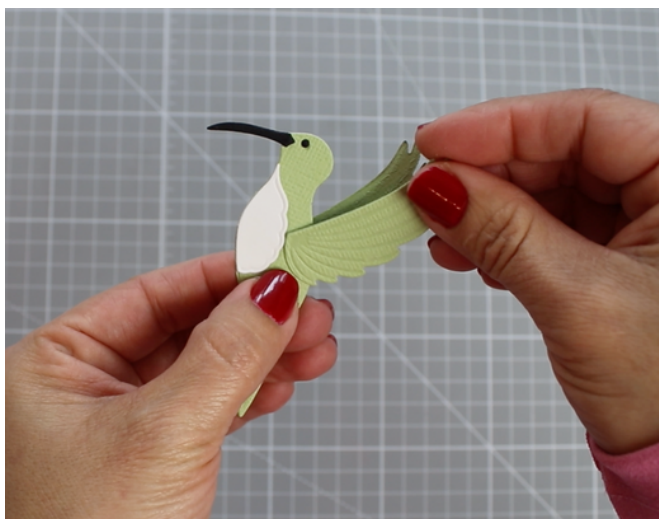
2. Glue the chest parts in both sides.



3. Glue the eyes. Then glue the bill in one side of the pop-up first.



4. Next, glue the other bill behind.

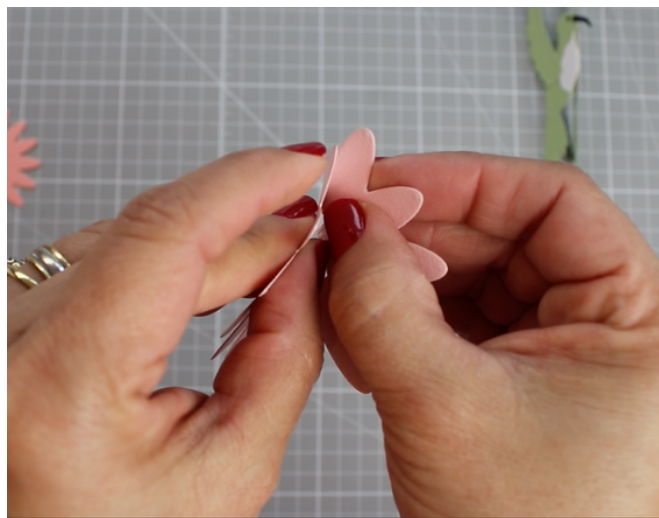
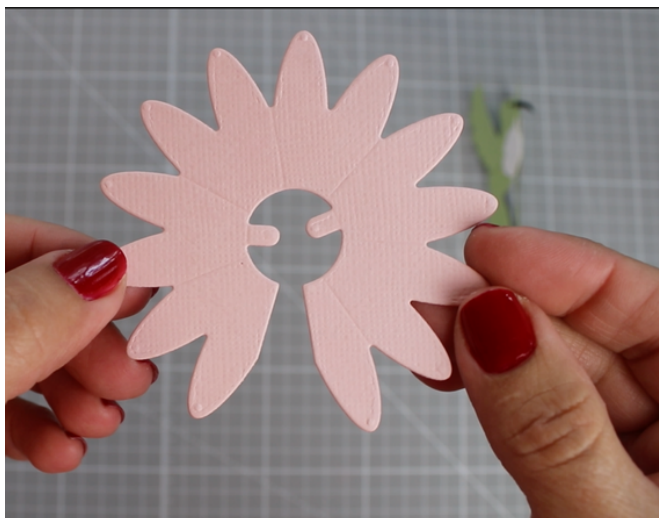


5. Glue one of the wings first. Then align and glue the other one at the other side.

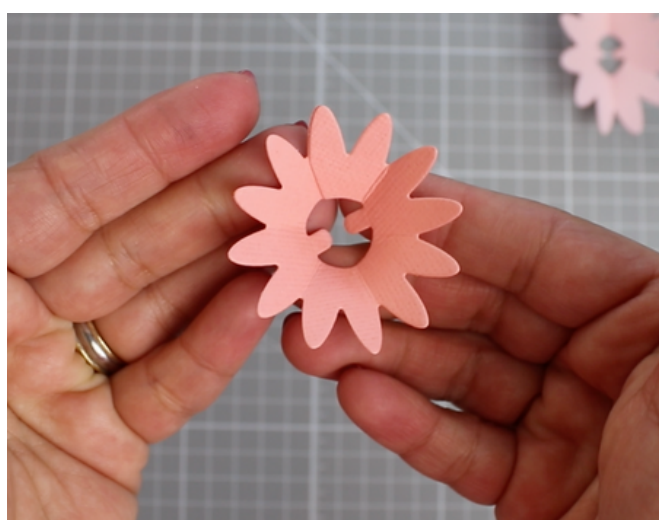
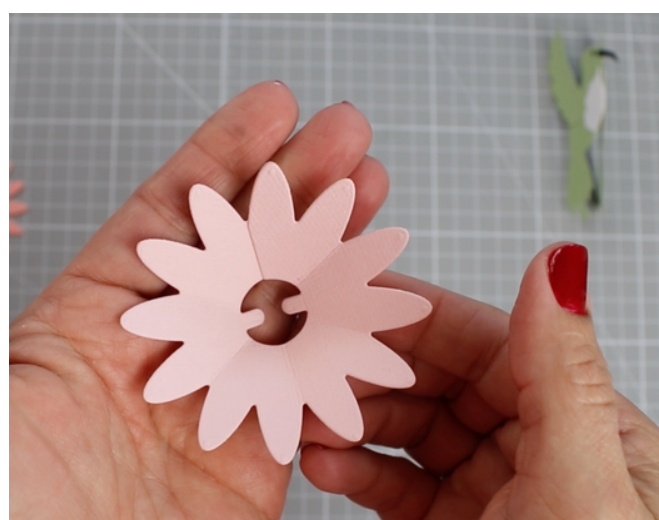


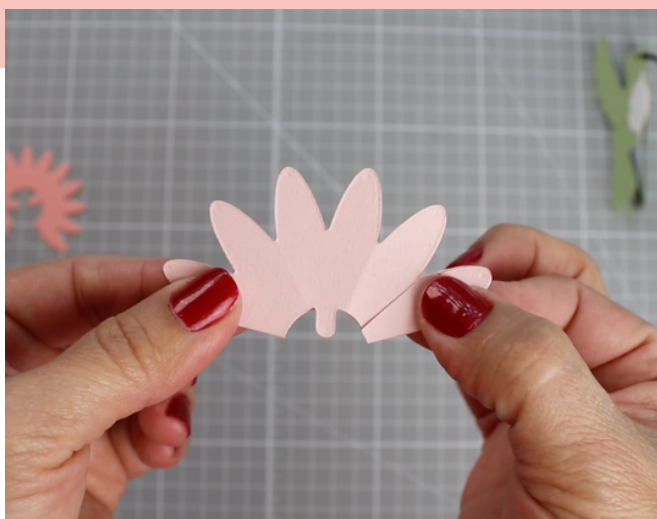
Your hummingbird should look like this

POP-UP FLOWER



6. There are 4 dies in the set that will create a pop-up flower. These four dies will score lines on each die-cut. First, bend the paper over the scoring lines to shape each one of them. Then glue the ends together as shown in the pictures.

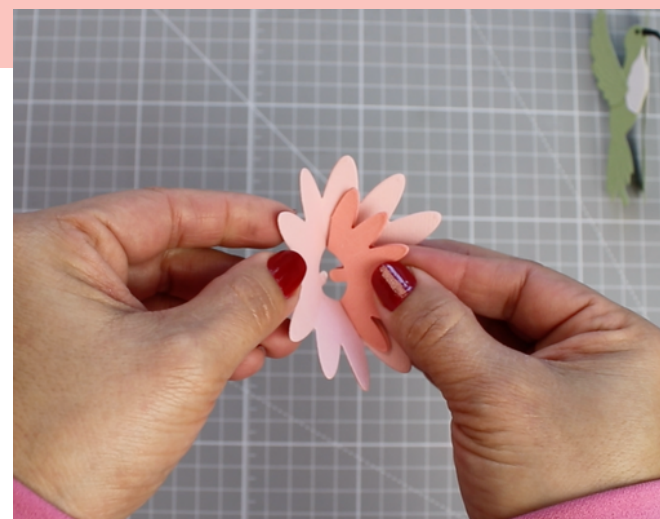




7. Fold each part of the flower in half making sure the two little bottom tabs are aligned.



8. Unfold the die cut and add glue on the two tabs as shown in the picture.



9. Align the tabs at the bottom of each flower part and glue them together.



The pop-up flower should look like this at this stage.



10. Apply glue over the bottom tabs.



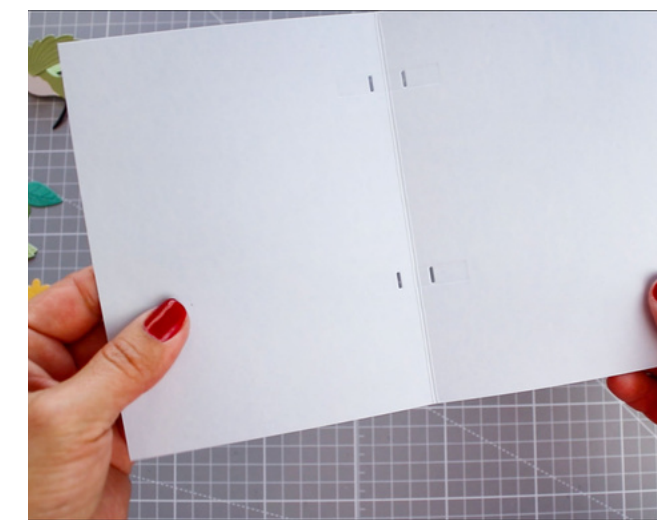
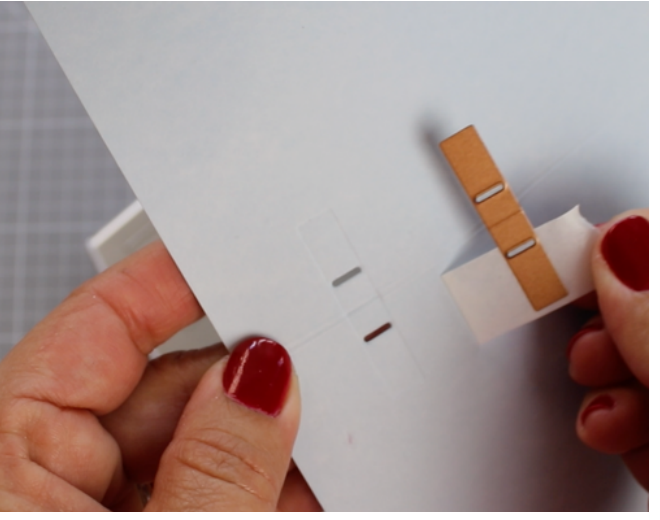
11. Glue the 3rd part of the pop-up flower making sure the tabs at the bottom are aligned.



The pop-up flower should look like this at this stage.



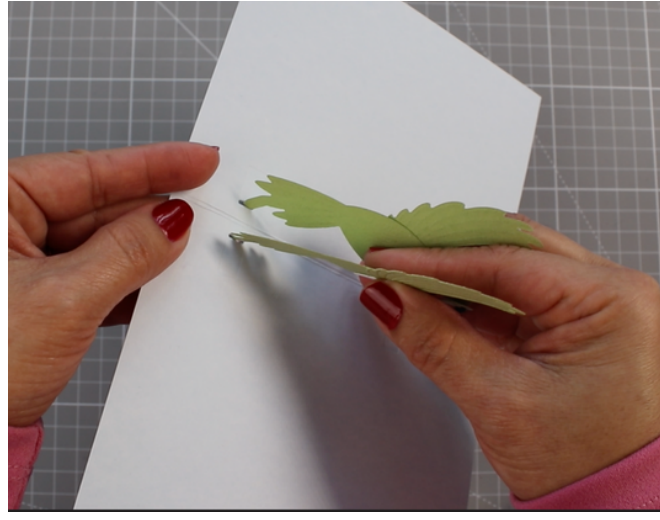
12. Align the centre of the die in the pictures with the pop-up insert scoring line. This will cut slots to attach the pop-ups. This pop-up insert measures 4-1/4" x 5-1/2" inches. It could be smaller or larger.



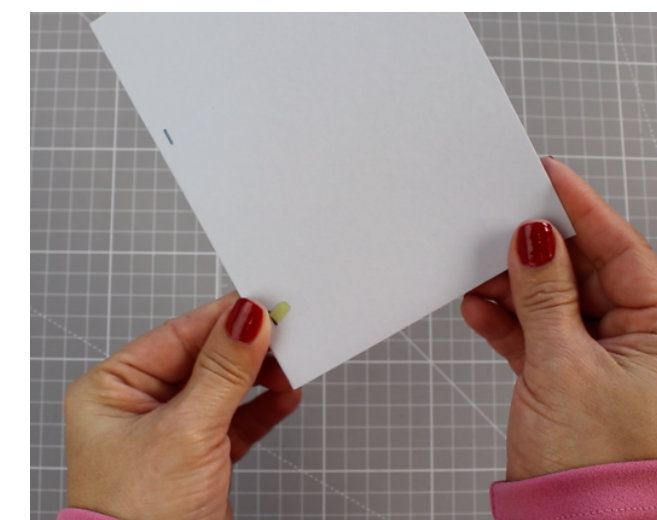
Cut a slot at 1" inch from the top of the pop-up insert and another one at 2" from the bottom.



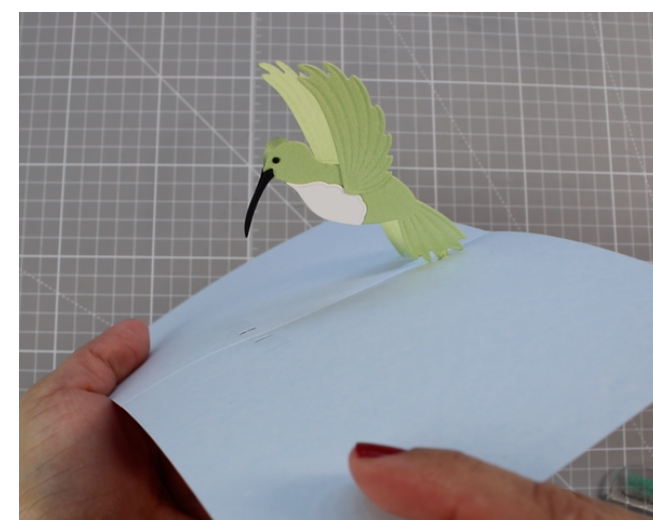
13. Add glue on the hummingbird bottom tabs.



14. insert the humminbird bottom tabs into the slots cut at 1" inch from the pop-up insert top edge .



15. Fold the tabs at the back to adhere them to the pop-up insert.



The Hummingbrd should look like this.



16. Insert the flower tabs into the slots cut at 2" inches from the bottom edge of the card base.



17. Apply glue on the tabs, fold, and glue them onto the pop-up insert.



18. Optional: glue small pieces of cardstock over the tabs to firmly affix them in place.



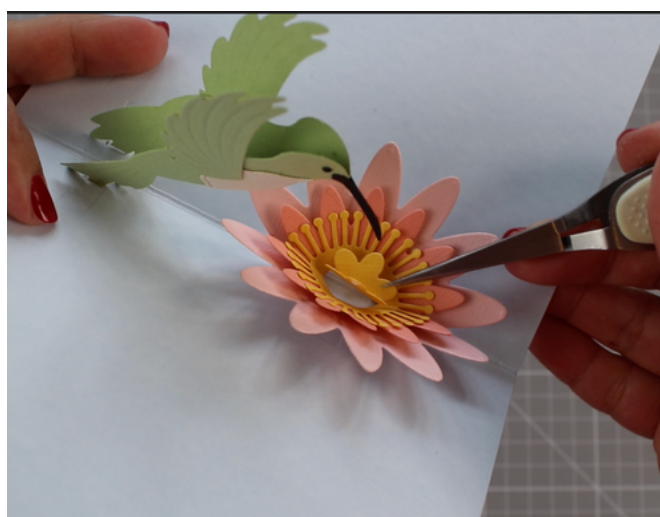
The pop-ups should look like this.



19. Fold this die-cut in half over the scoring line. This will cover the gap in the centre of the pop-up flower.



20. Add glue over the middle petals shown in the picture.



21. Aligning the scoring line in the die-cut with the card base scoring line and glue in place.



Fold the card base to help yourself to glue the pieces in place.



The Pop-Ups are done!



22. Place the pop-up insert inside a larger card base. Aligning its side fold with the card base scoring line. Add glue as shown in the picture.



23. Close the card base to adhere the pop-up insert in place.



24. Open the card and apply glue as shown on the other side of the pop-up insert.



25. Close the card and press down the card base to adhere in place.



26. Add decorative leaves or any other element you might want (avoid bulk)



You are done!



Oh! The pop-up hummingbird can be cut in half to create hummingbirds facing different directions.
