



#### **Indicator Light:**

Caps Indicator Light	Uppercase when light is on Lowercase when light is off	
Wireless Indicator Light	Press the "Fn+C" keys to pair the keyboard to the device. The light will turn off after successfully pairing.	
Charging Indicator Light	Blinking Red - Low battery or device is charging Solid Green - Charging is complete	



#### **Operating Instructions**

- 1. Install device, then open the cover, and use the stand on the rear of the case to prop up the device.
- 2. Turn on the keyboard by switching the On/Off switch to "ON"
- 3. Press "Fn+C" to pair your device with the keyboard
- 4. Open the Bluetooth settings on your device, and select "Wireless Keyboard".
- 5. Type the pairing code that shows on your device to complete the pairing process.
- 6. The keyboard is paired to your device, and ready to use

## Maintenance & Warnings

- 1. Do not squeeze, distort, or bend the keyboard
- 2. Keep the keyboard away from magnetic fields
- 3. Keep the keyboard away from liquids use in a dry environment
- 4. Use a soft cloth to clean your keyboard
- 5. Turn off the power, if the keyboard will not be used for a long period of time

#### Trouble Connecting?

- 1. Make sure your device and keyboard are both charged
- 2. Check to make sure your devices operating system is up to date
- 3. Turn off the keyboard
- 4. Turn off Bluetooth on your device
- 5. Turn on the keyboard
- 6. Turn on the Bluetooth on your device and try to repair
