

You can assemble that shelf two ways:






Standart Z-type


So you have 10 large triangles without round holes (Part#1), 3 large triangles WITH round holes (Part#2) and two small triangles (Part#3)




Step 1. Take Part#2 and Part#3 and connect them like on a picture:




Step 2. Add Part#1 from the left side




Step 3. Add another Part#1 from the bottom






Step 7. Add Part#2 (with round holes) from the left side





Step 22. Now it's time to connect all the triangles with provided wooden fastenings.



Take the "mother" connector and place it like that:



Then take the "father" connector and push it in, holding the "mother" connector from the other side. Repeat for all.



Then put the plugs on all the connection-free grooves



The wooden bars are simple hole-markers. Just connect them like that and map the holes on your wall. (Please, notice that you need only 6 small holes, the large hole in the middle is just for center your shelf) The mounting planks should be taken off the wall before hanging the shelf. Use 8mm drill and provided hooks and dowels for wall mounting.
