

Storm and wind damage, burns, UV damage, and products used for commercial use are specifically not covered. Damaae not covered under warranty may be repaired for a reasonable rate and a fee may be charged for shipping.

Service under this warranty is provided to the original consumer purchaser with proof of purchase from an AMPEX authorized dealer. AMPEX products purchased from unauthorized 3rd party retailers or in as-is or used condition are specifically not covered by this warranty. This warranty does not cover consequential damages, or any other losses caused by any defect in the product.

AMPEX products eligible for the Limited Lifetime Warranty are covered to the original owner, for the lifetime of the product.
