

Water Colours

Λ/FR^q

- · Blend easily to create subtle hues

Techniques:



Flat Wash Thin layer of paint applied evenly to the paper.



Gradated Wash Gradual change of colour intensity usually from dark to light.




Wet on Wet Wet paint is applied on wet paper, allowing the pigment to be soaked in.

How it works:



1. Wash the fabric with mild detergent or soap. Rinse thoroughly.



2. Put greaseproof paper or thick carboard beneath the fabric.

- · Bright, odourless, water-resistant paint to create personalised designs on fabric

How it works:



Colours can be mixed for greater variety.



Just let it dry for 1.5 hours, no ironing needed.



Wash the fabric after 24 hours of painting.

Do not dry clean.




Techniques:



Stroking Create a variety of expressive strokes such as lines, dots and waves, etc.



Smudging Using your finger, tissue paper to smudge the pastel into smooth coverage.



Blending Blend colours by stroking one colour into the next, overlapping strokes where the colours meet.

Aquash pastels

- \cdot Water-soluble oil pastels that mix well and can be used for creating beautiful watercolor gradient effect
- \cdot Each set comes with an Aquash Water Brush

Creative tips:











Techniques:



Gradating Stroke side to side with heavy pressure and lighten the pressure as you move away.



Layering Mix colour pencils by layering them lightly on paper. Use this to create shadows or highlights on an object.




Blending Blend colours by overlapping the strokes where the colours meet to create a smooth transition.



Hatching & Crosshatching
Draw a series of parallel lines (hatching)
and parallel lines layers in another direction
above the first set of lines (crosshatching).



Stippling Placing lots of tiny dots to create texture or shading.



Scumbling & Back and forth stroke Continuous circular marks or continuous back and forth motion without lifting your pencil off of the paper.

Watercolour Pencils











Techniques:



Pencil over wet paper Use a dry watercolour pencil to draw on top of the wet area.




Pencil over dry paper Draw using a dry watercolour pencil on dry area.



Wet pencil tip over dry paper Use a wet watercolour pencil to draw over the dry area.



Colour Blending Apply one colour on top of another colour and activate the area with water.



Pencil over dry paper with strokes of wet brush Use a dry watercolour pencil followed by a wet brush.



Pencil over wet blending Use a dry watercolour pencil on top of wet blended colours.

Be inspired and get creative!

1. Sticker

What you'll need:

- sticker paper
- scissors

Featured items:





Steps:





1. Draw or paint your artwork on sticker paper leaving about 1 cm between them, so there is room for cutting.



2. When you are happy with your design, cut around the illustration leaving 1-2 mm as a border.



TIP Use it to decorate your notebook, journal and more!

2. Watercolour Resist Art

What you'll need:

cardstock

Featured items:





Steps:



1. Draw a picture or write a message using white oil pastel on a sheet of white cardstock.



2. Paint over the artwork using watercolours and a large brush.



3. Reveal your secret message or picture.



Make it colourful by using different paint colours.

ತಿ. Scratch Art

What you'll need:

Featured item:

- cardstock
- bamboo skewer or toothpick



Steps:



1. Cover the entire card with oil pastel drawings. Make sure to make the layers thick.



3. Scratch your design using a stick such as bamboo skewer or toothpick.



2. Using the black oil pastel, colour the entire card until it's completely covered.





Wipe the bamboo skewer/toothpick after every scratch to ensure clean lines on your scratch art.

4. Eraser Stamp

What you'll need:

- eraser
- carving tool

Featured item:





Steps:



1. Draw a design on an eraser with a pencil and shade in the areas you want to carve away.



2. Using your carving tool, carefully carve out the shaded areas.

Note: Designs with letters should be done in mirror image, so that they appear correct when stamped.



3. Colour the surface of the stamp with a marker.



4. Start stamping!

5. Custom Tote Bag

What you'll need:

• canvas tote bag



Steps:



1. Pick a canvas tote bag and lightly iron it to obtain a smooth, stretched surface.



2. Using Fabric Fun Dye Sticks, start drawing your desired design or create stencils to draw on if you are a beginner.



3. Once you're satisfied with your design, cover it with a sheet of paper and press on it with a hot iron to set the dyes.



Work on an outline of your design and if possible draw in one direction.

6. Painted Shoes

What you'll need:

- canvas shoe
- painter's tape



Steps:



1. Remove shoe laces and tape off soles of shoes to protect them from paint.



2. Paint the shoes using acrylic or fabric paint and let them dry completely between different colors and layers of paint.



3. Once the shoes are painted and dry, spray a coat of fabric protector (optional).



You may use washi, masking or painter's tape to cover the soles.

\mathbb{Z}_{\circ} Recycled CD Coaster

What you'll need:

- recycled CDs or DVDs
- felt paper
- glue
- scissors

Featured items:





Steps:



1. Take a piece of felt, trace the shape of the CD on it and cut it out.



2. Paste it onto the CD to cover the hole in the middle.



3. Decorate on the surface of the felt using paint markers, acrylic paint, fabric paint.



4. Apply a layer of varnish as a final coat. Wait a few hours for the varnish to dry before use.

8. Dry Erase Board

What you'll need:

• photo frame

Featured items:



Steps:



1. Remove the backing of the photo frame.



2. On the surface that is facing the back of the photo frame, use acrylic paint to paint in your background.



3. Let it dry before fixing the photo frame.




4. Using a whiteboard or dry erase marker, you can now doodle or take notes on this DIY dry erase board.

Marble Envelope

What you'll need:

- art paper
- old envelope to use as template
- stick


Steps:



1. Trace the outline of the envelope.



2. Add drops of paints on the paper using at least 4 acrylic colours.



3. Using an ice cream stick or ruler, mix the colours in a sweeping motion.



4. Once the paint has dried, cut out and fold to complete the envelope.

10. Letter Vase

What you'll need:

Featured items:

- paper mache letters
- pen knife





Steps:



1. Use an X-acto knife or any sharp cutter to cut out the top part of the paper mache letters.



2. Draw or colour your letters using colour brushes or pens.



3. Fill your vase with flowers or succulents.



Mix and match colours to create fun patterns!

11. Puzzle

What you'll need:

- cardstock
- cutter

Featured item:



Steps:



1. Using your desired colouring tools, draw and color in your artwork.



2. Cut the artwork into as many pieces as you like using a cutter or scissors.



3. You've created a puzzle! Try piecing it back together to create your artwork again.



Doing puzzles is one of the best ways keep your brain engaged!

12. Paper Fan

What you'll need:

- cardboard
- cardstock
- ice cream stick

Featured item:





Steps:



1. Trace and cut out desired fan shape onto a piece of paper and cardboard.



2. Draw your design on the piece of paper and colour in using watercolor sticks or other choice of colouring materials.






3. Glue an ice cream stick onto the cardboard as a handle. Secure the ice cream stick handle by glueing designed paper over it such that the ice cream stick is wedged between the cardboard and paper.

13. Animal Bookmark

What you'll need:

- cardstock
- pen knife











1. Outline the head of an animal. Create the shape of the bookmark by outlining a rectangle that is connected to the animal's head. Draw in arms in a "U" shape.



2. Colour in your animal bookmark using colour pencils or markers connected to the animal's head



3. Cut out the shape of the bookmark. Using a pen knife or slicer, cut along the 'U' shaped flap, making sure that it is still attached to the head.



4. Insert the bookmark into a page, with the page wedged between the 'U' shaped flap and the body of the bookmark.

14. Leaf Stamp

What you'll need:

- cardstock
- dried leaves

Steps:



1. Find some leaf specimens with interesting shapes and textures.



3. Once the leaf is coloured, turn it over onto the surface you want to print on, and press down on the leaf firmly with your fingers.

Featured item:





2. Turn the leaf over onto a paper towel or piece of scrap paper, then color in the back of the leaf with paint markers.



4. Ensure that all parts of the leaf are being pressed down. Once done, gently peel the leaf away to get your leaf print.

15. Tie-Dye

What you'll need:

- t-shirt or cloth
- rubber band
- wash basin

Steps:



1. Prepare your piece of fabric by soaking it in water and wringing it such that it is slightly damp.

Featured items:

2. Starting from the middle of the fabric, twist it in clockwise manner to create folds.



3. Using a few rubber bands, secure the shape of the folded fabric and divide it into 6 parts.



4. Use your brush and fabric paint to add colour to each part — get creative!



5. Once done, allow the fabric to dry completely before removing the rubber bands to reveal your tie-dye design!

Note: There are many other tie-dye shirt preparation techniques that will result in different patterns.

16. Paper Plants


What you'll need:

- green art paper
- glue
- scissors
- wire

Steps:



1. Trace the shape of leaves on your green paper.







2. Cut out the shape of leaves.



3. Add the leaf details using a gel pen or metallic brush pen.



4. Add the "stems" using the wire. Use a needle nose plier to make a small loop in each wire and glue the loop to the back of each leaf.

17. Wrapping Paper

What you'll need:

- cardstock
- cutter


Featured item:



Steps:



1. Prepare plain sheets of recycled paper or wrapping paper, and some small items that can be used to stamp patterns such as bottle caps, fork, erasers, etc.



2. Using paint, color on the object and use it to create patterns of your choice on the recycled paper.



3. Wait for the ink to dry and use your freshly created wrapping paper for gifting!



Easily create fun patterns using simple shapes.

18. Gift Tag

What you'll need:

- cardstock
- cup
- string

Featured items:





Steps:



1. Get a thick piece of paper and draw an outline of gift tags.



2. Prepare a cup of diluted paint using watercolor paint and water.



3. Cut out the gift tags and dip them into the diluted paint to create a gradient color effect.



4. Use a ribbon or string to thread the hole and tie the ends together.

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
